A MESSAGE FROM FATHER PAT

Dear St. Pius X Community,

We are celebrating Trinity Sunday this weekend. One God and three distinct ways that we can relate to our God. Another way to look at this is Creator, Redeemer and Sustainer. There is no way that we will ever grasp this in any part of its entirety. It is a fundamental mystery of our faith; one that should cause us questions and draw us deeper into the reality of our God. 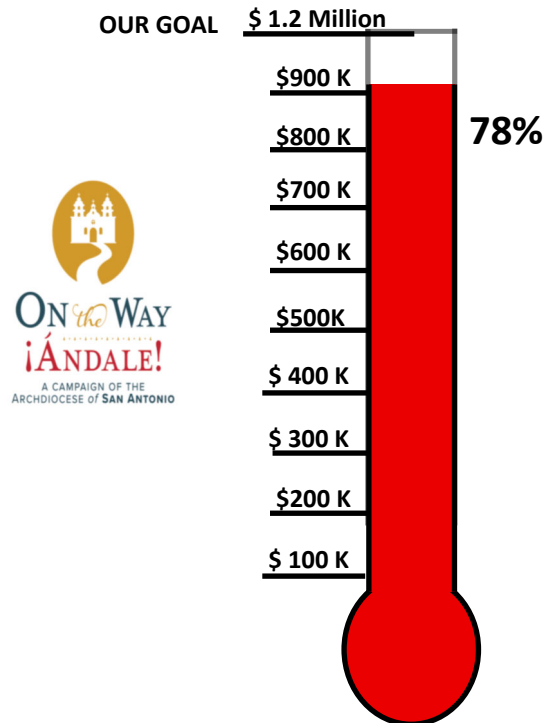

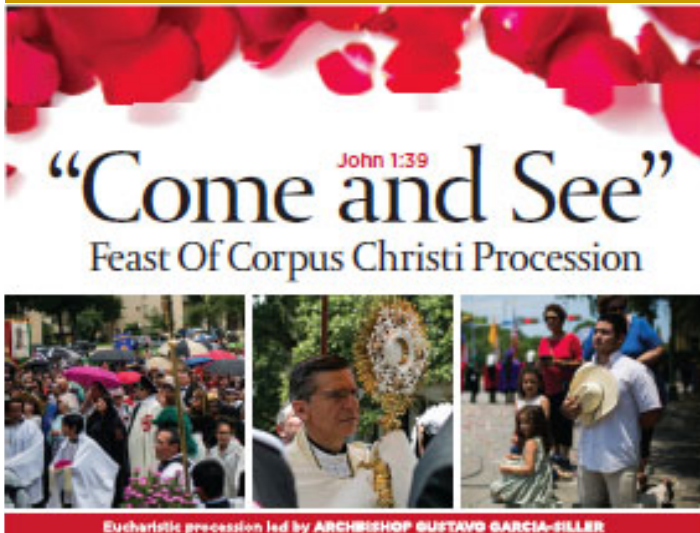

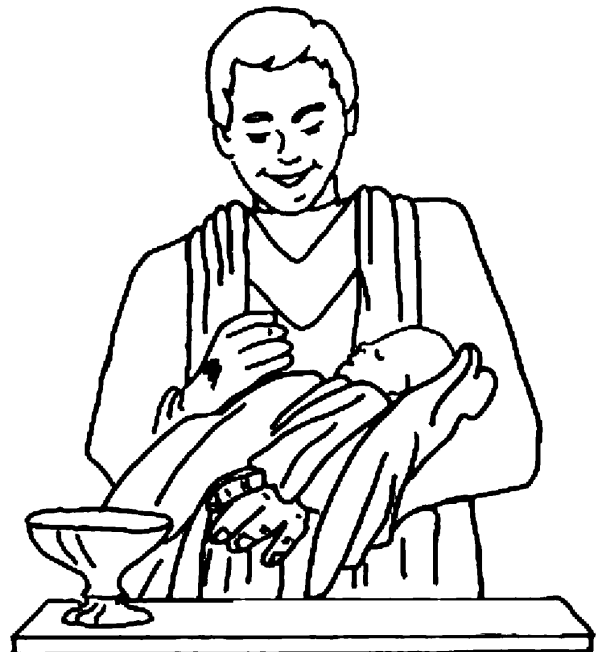

The Lay Ministry Institute (LMI) & Instituto de Formación Pastoral/Pastoral Formation Institute (IFP/PFI) are currently accepting applications for the 2018 - 2019 lay ministry formation programs. Both the LMI & IFP/PFI are two-year certificate programs.

The **IFP/PFI** is a basic adult faith formation program, offered in English or Spanish that affords the student an initial introduction to theological studies and personal leadership development for use in a pastoral setting. This is a two year Certificate course of study. Year 1 classes will be hosted at San Juan de los Lagos Parish and at St. Jude Parish.

The **LMI** is an intermediate level preparation program that builds on the student's foundational theological knowledge and personal spiritual formation. During this two year course of study, participants will also be discerning the call to ministry and guided through a practicum experience. All classes will be held on the OST Main Campus.
