A MESSAGE FROM FATHER PAT

Dear St. Pius X Community,

Watch for this number 210 756-3529. Just a teaser, you will not have to read much to find it....

I need your help. Most churches have closed their Blessed Sacrament Chapel. We have been instructed that if people don't respect social distancing, as well as public prayer in the chapel, it has to close. Over the weekend there was at least one gathering; this has to be the last one. The ventilation in the room is awful. The fan has to stay on and we are cleaning it almost nightly. Please help me. I don't want to close it, but if I have to for everyone's safety, I will. There are now four chairs plus one person can be on the center kneeler or floor. If you think I am overreacting, please read the article about the choir in Washington state; 45 out of 60 are infected.

On a happier note! Things are going surprisingly well. The response to live streaming has been amazing. I think we might have to keep some form of that going. Remember, we are open to serve whatever needs we can meet. We are slowly getting palms out to those who request them. If you don't need them or had them blessed during Mass, we will have them for you when you return. The last fish fry was a great success. THANK YOU ALL.

Those who came to the last fish fry may have noticed a new device, a DipJar. This is a device that we can set to a specific amount and every time someone "dips" their credit card into it, we will get that amount of money. They will usually be in the Blessed Sacrament Chapel and Holy Grounds when open.

On that same note, as we try to eliminate any barriers to people tithing, we have a text to give number—the number from above, (210) 756-3529. If you text that number, you will very easily be able to donate to the church. There will be info later this week or in next week's bulletin. We have it set up so that you can even designate different funds that you want your money to go to. For now, if you just text that number and put say \$250 in the body of

the text you will send us \$250. The first time there is some set up, but it is simple. We will do a video on it shortly.

We are working hard to stay connected. Until we can come back to Mass, I have upped the weekend intention number since we only have one Mass! Let us know if you think there is something more we can do to help the parish stay united and grow at this time.




