Guidelines and Examples

The following events are eligible for **ONE (1) Service Hour per family, per event:**

- ☐ Attending Orientation
- ☐ Attending Open House
- ☐ Attending a PTC General Meeting or Board Meeting
- ☐ Attending a School Council Meeting
- ☐ Attend a PTO or School Council committee, sub-committee or planning meeting in person
- ☐ Helping with a Classroom Party

The following event is eligible for **TWO (2) Service Hours per person, per event:**

- ☐ Attending Theology on Tap at the St. Pius X Church

The following event is eligible for **THREE (3) Service Hours per person, per event:**

- ☐ Field Trip Chaperone

The following events are eligible for a maximum of **TEN (10) Service Hours per family per event:**

- ☐ CYO Coach
- ☐ Parish Festival

The following events are eligible for **ACTUAL TIME WORKED per person, per event:**

- ☐ Gala
- ☐ Halloween Carnival
- ☐ Field Days
- ☐ Bike Rodeo
- ☐ Volunteer Substitute Teacher (not paid),
- ☐ Office worker
- ☐ Library worker
- ☐ Home Room Parent
- ☐ Summer maintenance work **2 hours credit for every hour worked**

You may also earn **one (1) service hour** for every \$10.00 worth of supplies/food you bring to the classroom for a program or class celebration (not birthday). Copies of receipts must be submitted for credit. Each family is eligible for a **maximum of five (5) service hours from this category.**
