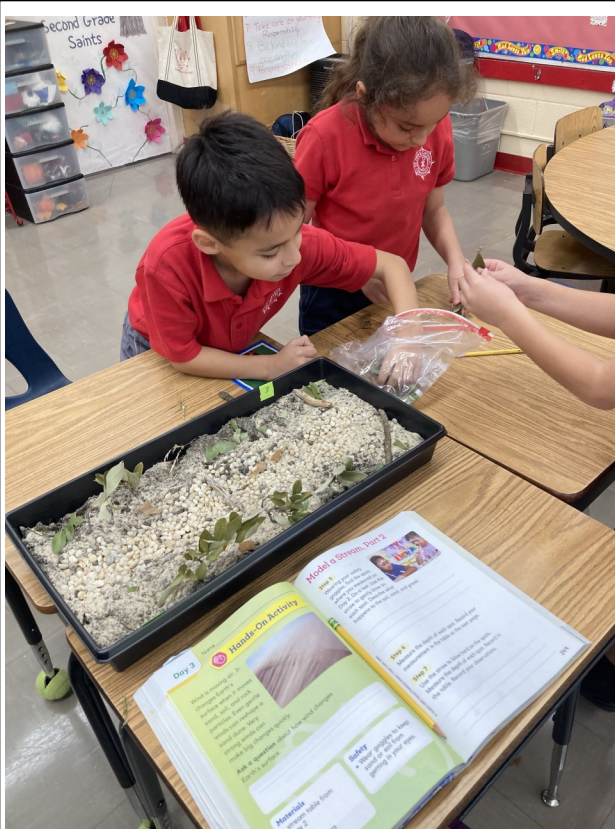

A GUIDE TO TEFA FOR FAMILIES

Senate Bill 2 established TEFA to help families access funds for approved educational expenses starting in 2026-27. With final rules released on November 25, 2025, families now have clarity on how the program will work.

ELIGIBILITY
Any Texas resident **eligible for public school (PK-12)** may apply.
This includes:
• Children entering PK-3-PK4 who meet Texas eligibility
• Students currently in public, private, or homeschool settings
• Students with TEFA qualifying disabilities
There is no income limit to apply, but awards are offered based on state priority groups.

PRIORITY GROUPS
BASED ON THE FPL (FEDERAL POVERTY LEVEL)

1	≤ 500% + Children with disabilities	≤ 200%	2
3	200% - 500%	≥ 500% (20% cap of total awards)	4

*Public school students may have priority in this group.

PARENT: As defined by Education Code, §29.351(5), a resident of this state who is a natural or adoptive parent, managing or possessory conservator, legal guardian, custodian, or other person with legal authority to act on behalf of a child.

PARENT RESPONSIBILITY
Families must:
• Use funds only for approved expenses
• Not withdraw cash or request reimbursement
• Keep receipts
• Ensure annual testing (grades 3-12)
• Report public school enrollment
• Follow all TEFA rules

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS
Choose **ONE** item from each column:

1 Proof of Residency • Lease, mortgage, or utility bill • Texas ID/driver's license • Voter registration • Government agency letter • Notarized affidavit	2 Proof of Citizenship • Birth certificate • U.S. passport • Naturalization certificate • DHS documents	3 Proof of Income • IRS transcript (if available) • Most recent tax return (2024) • Texas Workforce Commission income data
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WHAT IF FUNDS RUN OUT?
If funds run out, eligible students go on a state waitlist. If more funds become available, awards may be offered mid-year, prorated, and begin the month after approval.

WHAT'S NEXT?
When applications open on the Texas Comptroller Website, you will apply and select one approved school. Upon completion, eligibility will be determined. Awarding is expected to go out the first week of April. If your child is selected, you'll receive instructions to accept the award in the TEFA portal. Your child's TEFA account is then created so you can choose approved schools, providers, and services.

Continuous Enrollment

At **St. Pius X Catholic School**, we are proud to partner with families in the Catholic education of their children. In an effort to simplify the annual enrollment process, we have adopted **Continuous Enrollment**. **This means that once you enroll your child(ren) at St. Pius X, they will be considered enrolled until graduation, or until you notify us otherwise.** This agreement outlines the terms and expectations of Continuous Enrollment at St. Pius X Catholic School.

Terms of Continuous Enrollment

- 1. Automatic Re-enrollment** Beginning with the 2026-2027 academic year, all current students will be automatically re-enrolled for each subsequent school year unless a parent or guardian submits a written **Intent to Withdraw**.
- 2. Annual Notification of Changes** Families will receive an annual notice of any updates to tuition, fees, or policies on or before Catholic Schools Week (last week in January). These changes will become part of this agreement unless a written intent to withdraw is submitted.
- 3. Parishioner form**
A Parishioner form must be submitted to School Office each year in order to receive parishioner discount. This must be turned into the School Office by July of 2026. The SPX bookkeeper will send the School Office a list of all active, contributing SPX parishioners.
- 4. Withdrawal Policy**
If a family chooses not to continue enrollment for the next school year, they must notify the school in writing **by March 1st** of the current school year. Notices must be sent to: admissions@spxsa.org. Failure to notify the school by this date may result in financial penalties, as outlined in the current tuition agreement.
- 5. Tuition and Fees**
Tuition and fees are set annually and subject to change. By signing this agreement, you agree to comply with the school's tuition schedule and policies. All tuition charges will be posted to FACTS, and then discounts will be applied (such as parishioner, staff, sibling, military, or alumni). **Each student will have the non-parishioner tuition posted to their 2026-2027 FACTS account, and when their family's parishioner status is verified, the appropriate discount will be applied....**

This signed agreement must be returned to the School Office by the end of January.
