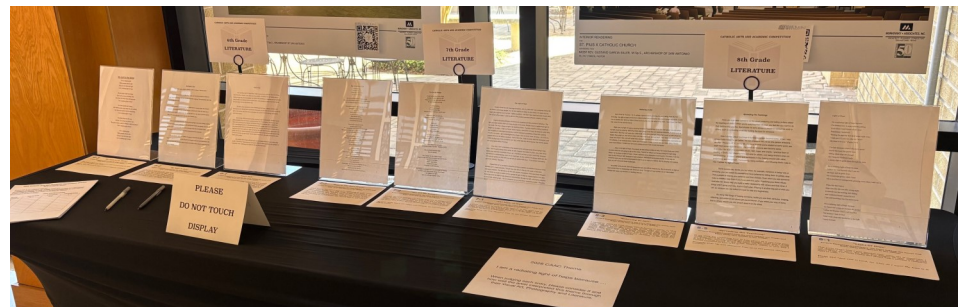

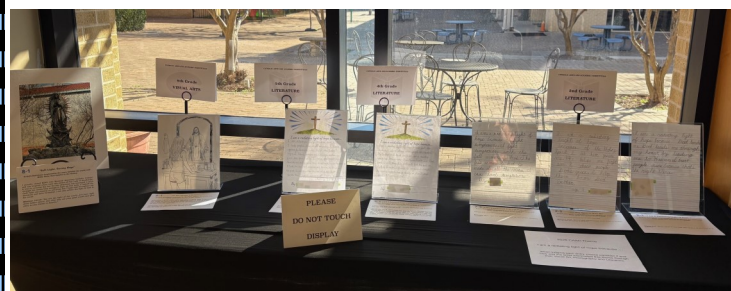

We'll have bid sheets out all weekend until 6:30 pm Sunday, or the option to "buy now" for a set price.

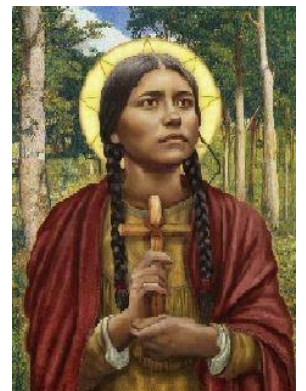

Virtue of the Month

Our virtue of the month for February was HONESTY. Honesty means being trustworthy and true. Everyone wants to be a man or woman of integrity. To have integrity, we need to let our faith carry through to every part of our lives. When our words match our actions, we are trustworthy and true.

If you want to be a person of honesty and integrity, the next time you're hesitant to say something, ask yourself these three questions: Is it true? Is it kind? Is it helpful?

Saint Kateri Tekakwitha is a saint who exemplifies honesty. She belonged to a Native American tribe near New York state. Her mother was a Christian, but her father was not. When her parents both died, and left her an orphan, Saint Kateri asked to be baptized and then promised her life to God. She traveled over 200 miles on foot to a Christian settlement of Native Americans and lived the rest of her life there, praying for and serving the people. After her death, people prayed to her for help, and miracles were performed through her intercession.

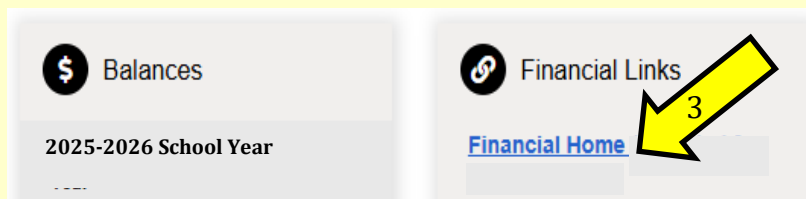

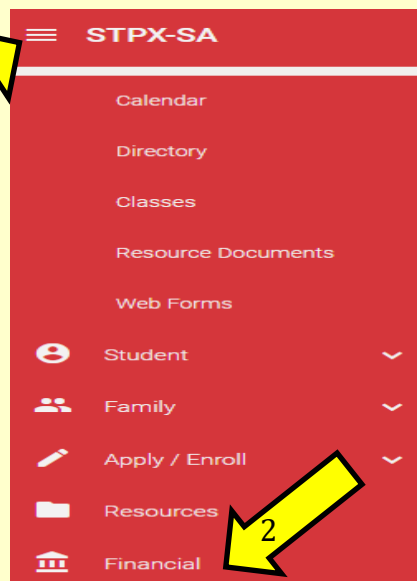

How to access payment info in your FACTS account—Tax time

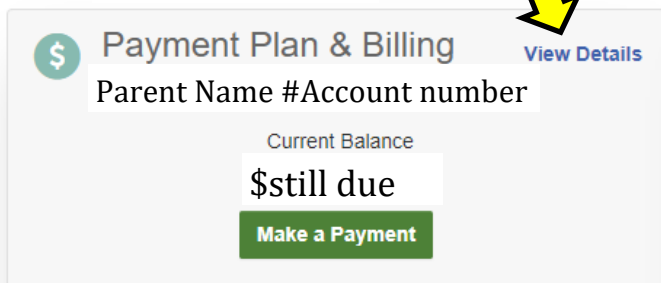

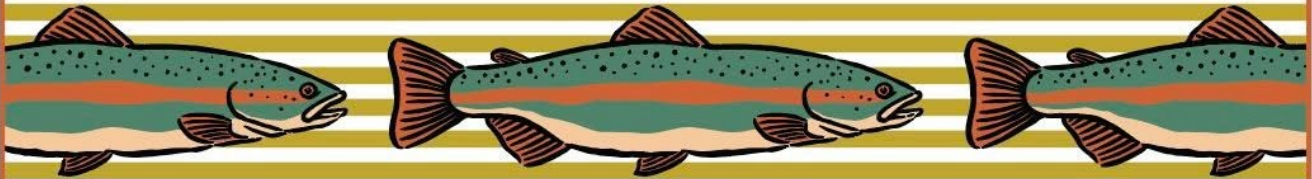

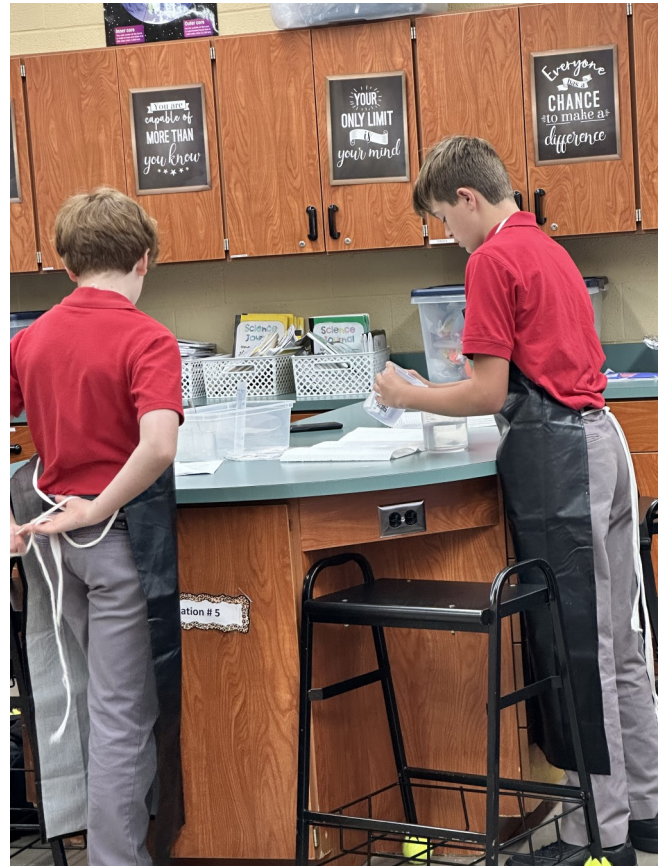

7th Grade Science



Mrs. Christian's 7th grade students investigated the amount of energy that is transferred to each level of a food chain by drawing a diagram and analyzing data. They also predicted the trend showing the amount of energy transferred to each trophic level.

Q: Could you define a trophic level?

(Either ask a 7th grader or take a peek at the answer below...)



A: The trophic levels refer to the position of a group of organisms in the food chain, food web, or ecological pyramid based on their feeding pattern. They are shown in a series or a succession to represent energy flow from one trophic level to another. The position of the trophic level depends upon the number of steps the organism takes from the start of the food chain until its consumption.

**The online application for TEFA opened on February 4, 2026
and will close on March 17, 2026**

It's the halfway point of family applications for Texas Education Freedom Accounts. If you haven't completed your child's application, now's the time!



Secure a spot in the lottery. The timing of your application has no bearing on your eligibility or the likelihood your child will be awarded an account for the 2026-27 school year.

You can update information later. Once your application is submitted, you can log into Odyssey's platform any time before March 17 to update information for your child.

Confirm your child's special education information. If your child has a disability, the sooner you confirm documentation, the better. If your child has an Individualized Education Plan (IEP) from the 2023-24 school year or more recent, the best way to confirm their information is with an accurate Texas Student Unique Identifier, or UID ([look up their UID online](#)). You will be asked to enter this information when you apply.

If your child doesn't have a current IEP, they have other options, including a [signed disability certification form](#).

The deadline is March 17 — less than three weeks away — and we don't want you to miss this opportunity.
