Learn more about the After School program?

Our Extended Day program is provided as an extension of the school day. Our Extended Day program includes: homework time, age appropriate games, outside recreational time, board games, and a variety of other activities that supplement our education programs at St. Pius X Catholic School. Monthly charges: (September 2026 to May 2027, 9 payments) Billed at the beginning of each month in FACTS

\$140 - one child

\$250 - two children (in same family)

\$350 - three or more children (in same family)

Drop in Charges: (+\$15 additional for noon dismissal days)

\$15.00 a day (for one child)

\$25.00 a day (for two children)

\$35.00 a day (for three or more children in the same family)

Supply fee will be billed (\$115) in FACTS after the second day your child attends Extended Day

Late Fee: \$1.00 per minute after 6pm

How do I...

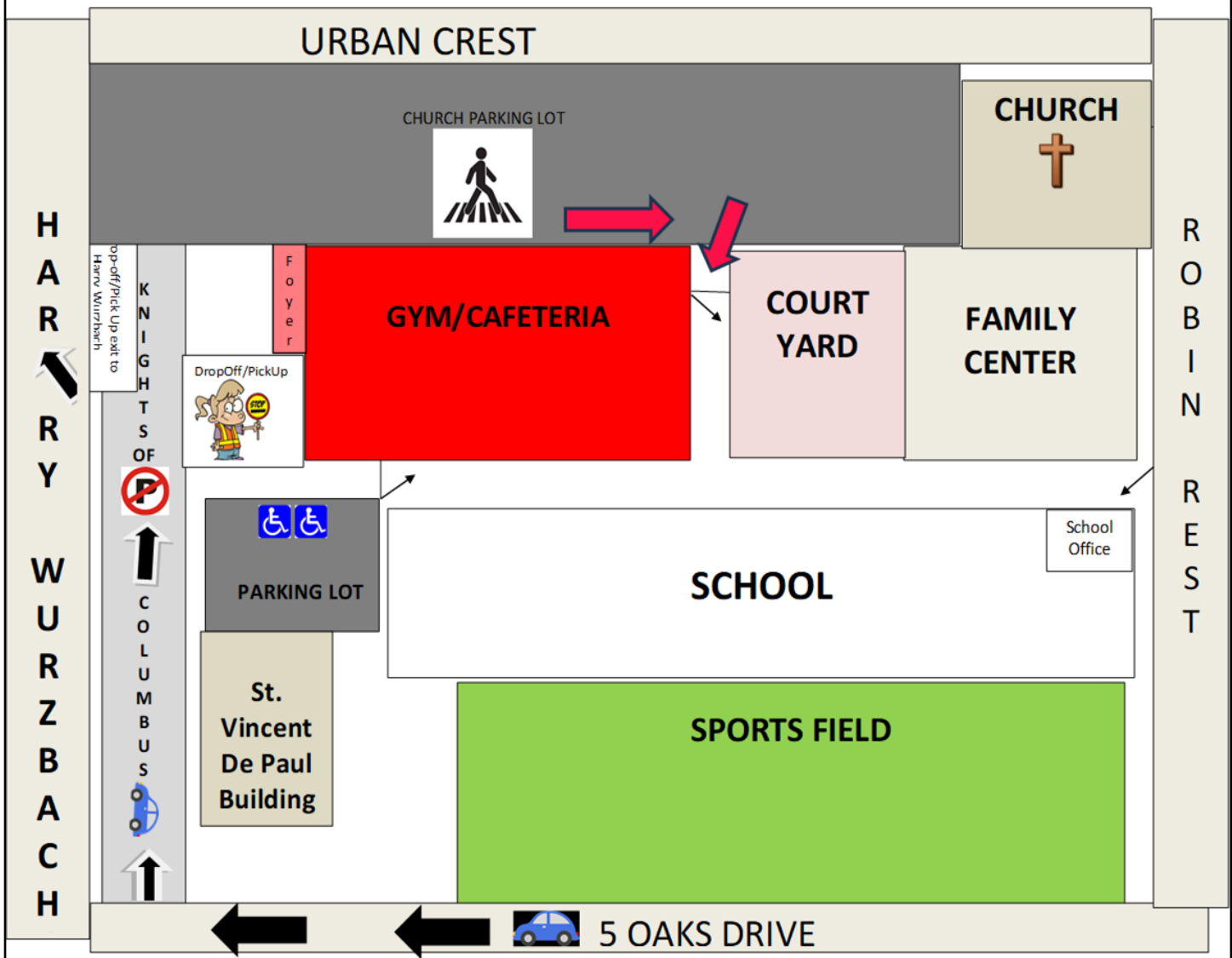
Drop off and pick up my student?

Our school day begins at 7:50am and ends at 3:15pm. Teachers are on campus starting at 7:10am and our PreK3 and PreK4 students may be walked directly to their classrooms, while our Kindergarten through 8th grade students may be dropped off in the SPX Gym between 7:10am and 7:40am. At 7:40am, their teachers will walk them to their respective classrooms. Before school care is included in the annual tuition. After 7:40am, students are dropped off in the School Office (Robin Rest) to walk down to their respective classrooms.

At 3:15pm, our students are dismissed from our SPX Gym.

Parents are welcome to use our car line (**you must stay in your car at all times in the car line**). In the case of long lines, the car line “wraps” around 5 Oaks Drive. If you prefer to drop off or pick up via walking, you may park in the SPX Church parking lot and walk to the courtyard/cafeteria door (across from the Family Center) to drop off/pick up your student(s).

We offer an Extended Day program which is an extension of the school day until 6:00pm. Students who are not picked up by 3:30pm will be sent to our Extended Day program. On Early dismissal days, students who are not picked up by 12:15pm will be sent to Extended Day.



What about school uniforms?



For the sake of uniformity, all school uniforms are to be purchased at [FlynnO'Hara](#). They are an **approved TEFA vendor**, **see our school website for more details.**

Socks and **solid black shoes** of the appropriate styles may be purchased at any location. See link for our uniform guidelines: [Click here for St. Pius X Uniform Information](#). Used Uniforms are available in the Rebel Closet at SPX, there is no charge, but donations are always welcome.

What is Spirit Dress Day? Once a month, usually the last Friday of the month, St. Pius X Catholic School celebrates by having a Spirit Dress Day. Students and staff are allowed to wear a SPX spirit shirt and blue jeans. If the weather is too warm for jeans, students will wear their uniform bottoms with their Spirit shirt. Students will wear any color tennis shoes (or their school shoes) on Spirit Dress Days. SPX Spirit shirts are available from the St. Pius X PTC. Students may also wear their SPX CYO shirt.

School Mass:

Our first School Mass for the 2026-2027 school year will be held on Wednesday, August 19, 2026 at 8:15a.m. Grades Kindergarten through 8th will attend. Our **PreK-4** students will join us at Mass after Labor Day, while our **PreK-3** students will be joining us at Mass in January of 2027.

Our regular weekly Mass days are **every Wednesday at 8:15am**. Parents and family are always welcome to join us at Mass. Students are required to wear their Full Dress Uniform on Mass Days.

Each week, a different class will take turns leading the Mass. It's so wonderful to see all of our students become leaders at Mass, even our littlest students will be able to participate.

How do I learn about volunteering?

In order to support the mission of our school, SPX depends upon and greatly appreciates active parent participation in the form of service to the SPX community. In addition, research shows that students are more successful when their parents are actively involved with their school.

Each family commits themselves to complete a minimum of 24 service hours (12 service hours per single parent household/deployed parent household) within a school year. The hours can be served by a parent, grandparents or a family member who is 18 years of age or older.

There are plenty of Service Hour opportunities both during school, after school and on the weekends. However, **families who do not complete their Service Hours** during a school year will have \$20.00 per incomplete service hour charged to their account to be paid in full by May.

Our FACTS Student Information System (FACTS SIS) gives you, the busy parent, an opportunity to get more involved in your child's academic progress and future success – all via the Internet!

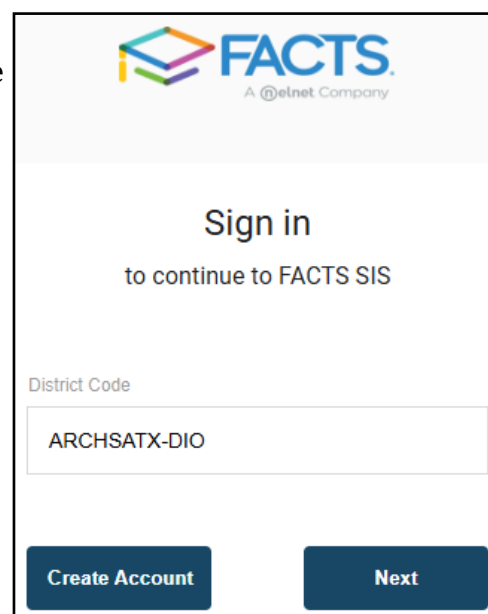

All you need is an Internet-capable computer.

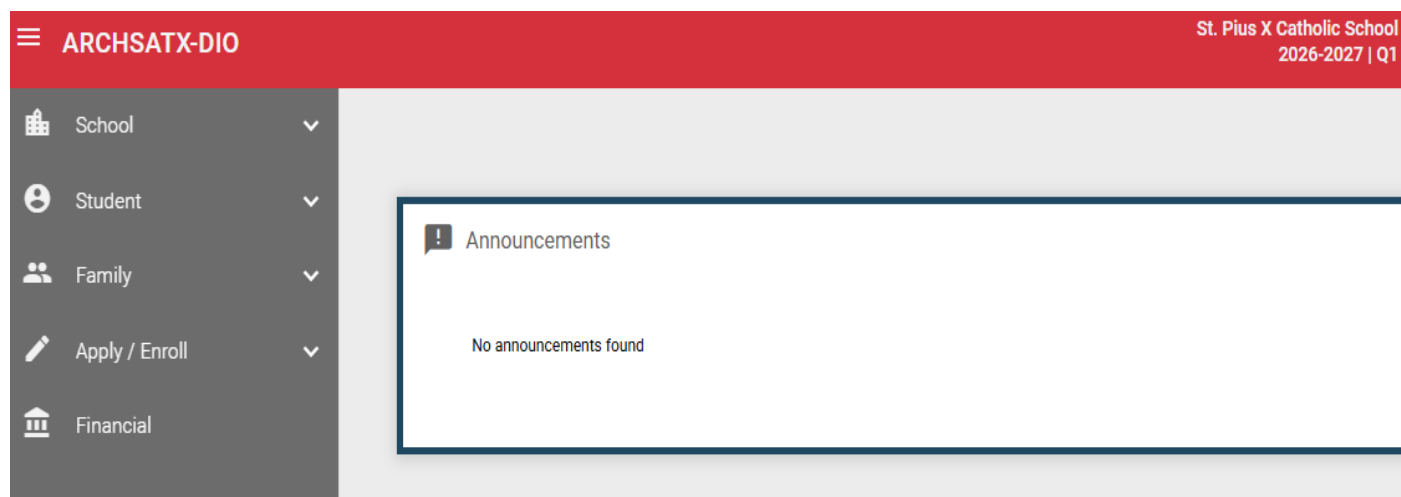
