SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED BEGINNING FEBRUARY 27, 2018.

Through the Louisiana Tuition Donation Program (formerly TDR), Arete Scholars provides K-12 scholarships to qualified low-to-moderate-income students, empowering parents to choose the nonpublic school that will best prepare your children for college, careers, and life.



ARETE SCHOLARS

Scholarships are awarded on a first-come, first-served basis, with priority given to current TDR and Louisiana Scholarship Program students. Award amounts are capped annually at 80% of the state’s per student expense for students in grades K-8 and 90% for high schoolers. **Current scholarship limits are \$4,205.09 for K-8 students and \$4,730.73 for grades 9-12.**

To be eligible for a scholarship in 2018-19, students must meet the following requirements:

- 1. Louisiana resident, **AND**
- 2. Enrolled in Louisiana public school for 2017-18, **OR**
 - Entering kindergarten in 2018-19, **OR**
 - Received a TDR scholarship or Louisiana Scholarship Program award in 2017-18, **AND**
- 3. Family income may not exceed the guidelines below

If your child meets **all** of the eligibility requirements you may apply online beginning February 27th at AreteScholars.org. The application link will go live at 9:00AM CST and a \$30 application processing fee will apply. In addition to your application, you will need to submit your most recent federal income tax return, all W-2 forms, proof of residency, and supporting documentation for non-taxable income. A complete list of required documents can be found on our website.

The application deadline is currently April 30, 2018. Check AreteScholars.org for updates or changes to the deadline. Funding is limited, and application does not guarantee a scholarship.
