An Update from the Administrator

Dear family in Christ,

I want to give you all an update on the state of the parish grouping. You might have noticed that through the very hard work by our staff, we have combined the way we communicate to our three parishes. We now have one common bulletin and one common website.

I have also had meetings with the Finance Councils of all three parishes and have exciting news! Because of the generosity and hard work of so many at St. Patrick Church (fish fries, festival, and many other fundraising events), we will be putting a new roof on the school starting in July. Through the generosity of the parishioners, at Holy Rosary we have installed a new security and fire alarm system for the protection of our faith community, and at Miraculous Medal we have updated our security system and have completed a handicap access restroom at the Miraculous Medal Banquet Hall!

The Pastoral Councils of all three parishes worked together on a new mission statement. A mission statement tells us who we are, where we are, and what we are doing. In unity, the Pastoral Councils would like to share our new mission statement:

We, the Roman Catholic churches of Holy Rosary, Miraculous Medal, and St. Patrick, enlightened by the Word of God, guided by the Holy Spirit, and called to spread God's love, through our actions and words, to bring into an intimate relationship with Jesus all those living in North Central Washington County.

Currently, we have formed an Advisory Council which will help us craft a Vision Statement that will explain where, we as a new parish, will want to go in the future. The Advisory Council is comprised of parishioners of various backgrounds, who are not currently involved in parish leadership roles. The Pastoral Councils want to hear their voice.

Also, the ministry and organization leaders will get together on March 20th to continue to discuss communication and collaboration and to ask the Lord to lead and guide us in our mission.

While many changes are happening, I am excited about the opportunities that Jesus has given us to serve Him in this part of His vineyard. Please continue to pray for our parishes as we go forward and look for further updates in the future through the bulletin and Town Hall meetings.

Una Actualización del Administrador

Querido familia en Cristo:

Quiero darles a todos una actualización sobre el estado de la agrupación parroquial. Habrán notado que a través del arduo trabajo de nuestro personal, hemos combinado la forma en que nos comunicamos con nuestras tres parroquias. Ahora tenemos un boletín común y un sitio web común.

También he tenido reuniones con los Consejos de Finanzas de las tres parroquias y tengo noticias emocionantes! Gracias a la generosidad y el trabajo duro de tantos en la Iglesia de San Patricio (la venta de pescado frito, el festival, y muchos otros eventos de recaudación de fondos), vamos a poner un nuevo techo en la escuela a partir de julio. Gracias a la generosidad de los miembros de la parroquia, en la iglesia del Santo Rosario hemos instalado un nuevo sistema de seguridad y alarma contra incendios para la protección de nuestra comunidad, y en Medalla Milagrosa hemos actualizado nuestro sistema de seguridad y hemos completado un baño con acceso para discapacitados en el Salón de Banquetes de la Medalla Milagrosa.

Los Consejos Pastorales de las tres parroquias trabajaron juntos en una nueva declaración de misión. Una declaración de misión nos dice quiénes somos, dónde estamos y qué estamos haciendo. En unidad a los Consejos Pastorales, me gustaría compartir con ustedes nuestra nueva declaración de misión:

Nosotros, las iglesias Católicas Romanas DEL Santo Rosario, Medalla Milagrosa y San Patricio, iluminados por la Palabra de Dios, guiados por el Espíritu Santo, y llamados a difundir el amor de Dios, a través de nuestras acciones y palabras, para hacer que todos los que viven en el norte central del Condado de Washington tengan una relación íntima con Jesucristo.

También, los líderes de los ministerios y las organizaciones se reunirán el 20 de marzo para continuar discutiendo la comunicación y la colaboración y para pedirle al Señor que nos guíe en nuestra misión.

Mientras todos estos cambios están ocurriendo, yo estoy emocionado por las oportunidades que Jesús nos ha dado para servirle en esta parte de su viña. TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

By now, many may have failed in Lenten discipline to some measure or another: the daily doughnut is simply too alluring, or a furtive puff on a cigarette irresistible. There is meaning even in the failure, though, a kind of reminder that we cannot save ourselves. Part of the power of Lent is that we do it together, and although individuals decide on different ways to keep it, it is fundamentally the same journey. We fall, we get up, we keep moving. The desire to "give something up" for Lent is an age old impulse in the Christian heart. We get better at it over the years, and move more deeply into the meaning and message of acts of sacrifice; so there is no shame in stumbling, as long as we are not discouraged by the failure and give up. We are clearing space in our lives, after all, and some of the things we desire to give up are worth rooting out completely anyway. What do we do with the space we have cleared out by our sacrifice? The Lenten question of giving up is balanced by the Easter question of our response to Christ's embrace of us in love: "What are you taking on for Easter?"—James Field, Copyright © J. S. Paluch Co.
