

3.- HACIA UNA COHERENCIA CADA VEZ MAYOR

Al tomar conciencia de las dificultades que tenemos que afrontar para vivir la fe con coherencia, no buscamos abrumarnos o desalentamos. Se trata de vivir en un sano realismo: la incoherencia, mayor o menor, la experimentamos todos y nos acompañará mientras estemos como peregrinos en este mundo. 4.- COHERENCIA Y APOSTOLADO

Cada cual en su puesto y lugar, desde el propio estado de vida, nuestra misión es la de anunciar el Evangelio, transmitir al Señor y hacer partícipes a muchos otros del don de la reconciliación que Él nos ha traído. Ello implica necesariamente que yo mismo me esfuerce por ser el primero en acoger y vivir el Evangelio con máxima coherencia.

El Concilio Vaticano II ha enseñado que, con frecuencia, la incoherencia de los creyentes constituye un obstáculo en el camino de cuantos buscan al Señor». La incoherencia afecta, según el grado, nuestro propio testimonio, y puede tomar estéril la Palabra que estamos llamados a proclamar y transmitir. Tomar conciencia de la necesidad de ser coherentes con la fe que predicamos para que el apostolado sea fecundo y eficaz es una fuerte motivación en el camino cotidiano de nuestra propia santificación.

En este empeño tengamos en cuenta aquél dicho que reza: "Las palabras mueven, el ejemplo arrastra". Y es que cuanto más se refleje Cristo en nuestra vida, tanto más mostrará la atracción irresistible que él mismo anunció hablando de su muerte en la cruz: "Cuando yo sea elevado sobre la tierra, atraeré a todos hada mi". ¡Cuánto apela, cuestiona, mueve los corazones, por la firmeza, paz y seguridad que transmite, el testimonio de una persona que es coherente con el Evangelio ¡Cuántos al verlo, al verla, feliz, radiante, dicen: "yo quiero eso para mí", "yo quiero ser así"! 

Visit the National Shrine of Our Lady of Lourdes and the St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Shrine



A one-day bus trip to the National Grotto of Our Lady of Lourdes and the St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Shrine is scheduled for

THURSDAY, JUNE 27

Included in this pilgrimage will be time spent at the National Shrine of Our Lady of Lourdes, located on the mountain above Mt. St. Mary's Seminary. "Mary's Mountain" is extremely peaceful and beautiful.

This National Shrine Grotto of Our Lady of Lourdes began as a shrine with a simple cross attached to a tree by Fr. Simon DuBois, the founder of Mt. St.

Mary's Seminary. A chapel was built on this site where Mother Seton would pray and teach during her early years in Emmitsburg. The Grotto honoring Our Lady of Lourdes was built in 1875. It is a replica of that experienced in Lourdes, France. In 1965 it received national designation when it was named a public oratory. By then a Rosary Path, Stations of the Cross, and a number of other shrines honoring Mary and other saints had been established on the site.

Today, a rock from Lourdes, presented by the Bishop of Lourdes in 2005, is located in the grotto stone.

After time here we'll move a few miles to the resting place of the first American Saint — Elizabeth Ann Seton where we'll have a box lunch on the grounds. Mass, a video of her life and a tour of her "Emmistburg homes" — the log cabin and White House, will be provided. Seeing where she lived and prayed, and where she began a remarkable mission with the Sisters of Charity of the United States are special times,
