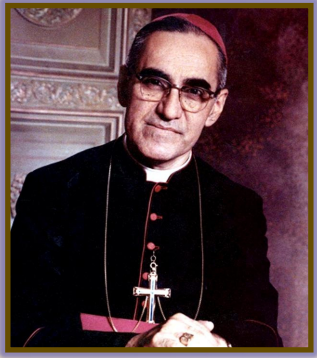

### Anticipation of the feast of SAN OSCAR ROMERO

**MARCH 22 at 1:00 PM (Spanish Mass)**

We will have a special procession and music at the Spanish mass on Sunday, March 22 in honor of St. Oscar Romero. After mass, we will be graced by the presence of a Latino music ministry group from St. Martin of Tours parish in Gaithersburg, MD called: Jesus Te Ama. Please join us for praise and worship in Spanish after Mass.

San Oscar Romero, a bishop and martyr during the civil war of the 1970's in El Salvador, was assassinated while in the midst of celebrating mass on March 24, 1980. Pope Francis said at his canonization: "His ministry was distinguished by his particular attention to the most poor and marginalized." We look forward to you joining us in honoring God's work of mercy accomplished through his humble servant.

Lord, we pray for the protection of all refugees, migrants and displaced people in the world today.

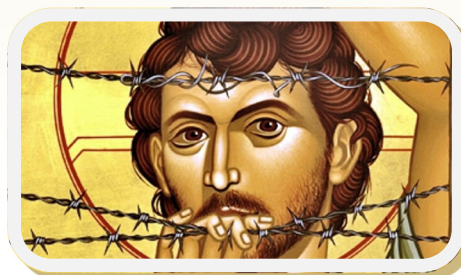
You experienced the life of a refugee in the flight to Egypt, when Joseph and Mary fled their home to protect your life.

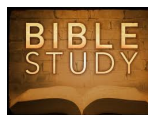

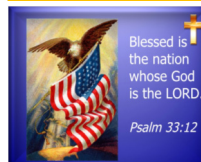

### ¿CÓMO VIVIR LA CUARESMA? (primera parte)

Cuarenta días, cuarenta noches: la palabra Cuaresma se deriva de cuarenta. En sí, esta palabra recuerda los cuarenta años pasados por el pueblo hebreo en el desierto, entre la salida de Egipto opulento y la entrada a la tierra prometida...

#### Tiempo de preparación para la Pascua

Cuarenta días, cuarenta noches: la palabra Cuaresma se deriva de cuarenta. En sí, esta palabra recuerda los cuarenta años pasados por el pueblo hebreo en el desierto, entre la salida de Egipto opulento y la entrada a la tierra prometida (cfr. libro del Éxodo); pero también los cuarenta días y cuarenta noches de la peregrinación de Elías, hasta la montaña de Dios en el Horeb (I Reyes 19, 8); y los cuarenta días pasados por Jesús en el desierto, a donde fue llevado por el Espíritu después de su bautismo, antes de emprender el camino de predicar la Palabra de Dios (Mateo c. 4).

#### Nos prepara a la Pascua

Desde los primeros tiempos de la Iglesia, la Cuaresma es esencialmente el tiempo de preparación para la celebración de la Pascua y, por la misma razón, el tiempo de preparación de los catecúmenos para recibir el bautismo.

Pero son los textos del Evangelio quienes estructuran la liturgia de la Cuaresma: las tentaciones de Jesús en el desierto, el ciego del nacimiento, el diálogo con la Samaritana y la resurrección de Lázaro señalan el recorrido de iniciación cristiana propuesto a todos los que serán bautizados en Pascua, y también a todo bautizado en memoria de su bautismo.

#### Darnos tiempo

La Cuaresma es, pues, considerada como un tiempo durante el cual los cristianos se ponen más intensamente ante el misterio de su fe, para prepararse plenamente a la Pascua: vida, muerte y resurrección de Jesucristo. Para que se acuerden de los cuarenta días de Jesús en el desierto y de las tentaciones que Él sufrió, los cristianos dedican un tiempo a la oración, al ayuno y a la conversión. Es, pues, solamente, a la luz de la Pascua que podemos comprender esta cuarentena, que señala el tiempo de nuestra marcha hacia Dios.

Somos tiempo, porque no tenemos hoy los mismos ritmos que antes, y el tiempo no está estructurado de la misma manera regular para todos. Aún el domingo ha perdido mucho de su matiz y, excepto la interrupción de la vida profesional, apenas se distingue de los demás días.

Por tanto, sea cual sea la manera, busquemos comprender lo que queremos vivir. Darnos tiempo de recordar, de prepararnos, de escucharnos a nosotros mismos, a los otros.

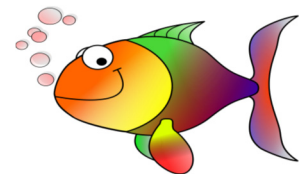
