

FIRST READING – Dt 8:2-3, 14B-16A

SECOND READING – 1 Cor 10:16-17

Brothers and sisters: The cup of blessing that we bless, is it not a participation in the blood of Christ? The bread that we break, is it not a participation in the body of Christ? Because the loaf of bread is one, we, though many, are one body, for we all partake of the one loaf.

GOSPEL READING – Jn 6:51-58

Jesus said to the Jewish crowds: "I am the living bread that came down from heaven; whoever eats this bread will live forever; and the bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world."

The Jews quarreled among themselves, saying, "How can this man give us his flesh to eat?" Jesus said to them, "Amen, amen, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you do not have life within you. Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life, and I will raise him on the last day. For my flesh is true food, and my blood is true drink. Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me and I in him. Just as the living Father sent me and I have life because of the Father, so also the one who feeds on me will have life because of me. This is the bread that came down from heaven. Unlike your ancestors who ate and still died, whoever eats this bread will live forever."

PROFESSION OF FAITH

I believe in one God, the Father almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all things visible and invisible. I believe in one Lord Jesus Christ, the Only Begotten Son of God, born of the Father before all ages. God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God, begotten, not made, consubstantial with the Father; through Him, all things were made. For us men and for our salvation He came down from heaven, *and by the Holy Spirit was incarnate of the Virgin Mary, and became man*. For our sake, He was crucified under Pontius Pilate, He suffered death and was buried, and rose again on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures. He ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead and his kingdom will have no end.

I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life, who proceeds from the Father and the Son, who with the Father and the Son is adored and glorified, who has spoken through the prophets. I believe in One, Holy, Catholic and Apostolic Church. I confess one Baptism for the forgiveness of sins and I look forward to the resurrection of the dead and the life of the world to come. Amen.



MASS INTENTIONS EXPLAINED

The tradition of a person requesting a specific intention at a Mass for someone goes back as far as the second century of the Church. It is a beautiful thing to pray for each other. There are many reasons to ask for the priest to offer the Mass: for someone who has died, for thanksgiving for a gift from God, for an anniversary or birthday. All of these will be offered during a Mass as the priest's intention for that Mass.

Although we request a donation, or stipend, for the intention, this should not be confused as "buying" a Mass. The offering for the intention does not make the Mass "your mass." It is still the universal and eternal sacrifice of Jesus being re-presented on the altar. The Mass has infinite value and cannot be contained by a donation. We strongly encourage the faithful to pray unceasingly for themselves and for others. Whether in the Mass setting or outside of the Mass, these prayers are efficacious and are heard by Our Father in heaven. God knows your intention and it is valid whether anyone else knows you were the one asking for it, or even if the priest forgets to utter the intention aloud. God's pretty amazing in that way!

SPIRITUAL ADOPTION UPDATE

MONTH 1 - Developing Baby - My heart is beating



Your spiritually adopted baby has been quite active over the past month. Already your baby is 10,000 times bigger than at conception. Your baby has developed the foundations of his brain, spinal cord, and nervous system by the 20th day. His heart began to beat on the 21st day, pumping blood through its own circulatory system and the blood type can be different from his mother's. Your baby is most vulnerable during the next month of being aborted. Pray that the Lord of Life might move the heart of his mother to give him the most precious gift of all - the gift of life.

ORDER OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION

The Order of Christian Initiation of Adults, formerly RCIA, is an adult faith formation process of conversion leading to reception into full communion with the Catholic Church.
