I am especially grateful to Celeste Ammerman, whose outstanding work and wise council keeps our parish in good financial shape.

What we have planned for 2026

The Capital Campaign

As you may remember, this past Spring, our parish underwent a Pre-Campaign Study to help us plan and prepare for a Capital Campaign. The results of the study were presented to our Finance Council and Parish Council in July. The results were overwhelmingly positive. We are immensely grateful to all the parish families that took the time to participate.

We are pleased to announce that based on the feedback provided by parishioners during the study and the positive results Ruotolo Associates gathered, we will be able to proceed with establishing the necessary components that will make our campaign successful. We are now in the planning stages of the campaign.

Over the course of the next few months, you will be hearing more about our effort to upgrade, repair, and improve our facilities. Everyone in the parish will have the opportunity to hear more about the campaign directly from our parish leadership and will be provided with the chance to ask questions. We ask for your patience during this time and look forward to your support in this important effort for our parish!

The Diocesan Ministries Appeal

Because we are kicking off a Capital Campaign, we will not be participating in the Annual Diocesan Ministries Appeal for 2025.

Online Giving

During the last few months, we have made the switch from eCatholic online giving to ParishSoft giving. Thank you to everyone who bore with us as we made this transition. Special thanks go to Lynda Rogalski and Noelle Houghton on our staff who did so much of the behind-the-scenes work of this important change.

Financial Transparency

Thanks to the feedback received in our parish survey and the work that Ruotolo Associates have done, we have tried to be more transparent with the finances of the parish. In addition to the information presented below, we now have a column in our bulletin, updated every month, which has information about parish income, parish expenses, and how we are managing our building and maintenance fund. Please continue to keep the feedback coming!

School Building

We have been actively working with the diocese to find a tenant for our school building but have not found the right tenants who are willing to pay the right price. While it is frustrating that we are not able to rent it out, the school is being put to good use in the meantime as it has become the new home for our first to fifth grade religious education classes.


Edificio Escolar





ST. FRANCIS CELEBRATION AND OCTOBER MONTH OF SERVICE

It was while living with and serving the lepers and poor that St. Francis of Assisi saw the face of God most clearly. Since then, service is at the heart of what it means to be a Franciscan Community. To celebrate the Feast Day of St. Francis of Assisi this year, we are encouraging everyone to participate in at least one act of service during the month of October. Below is a list of opportunities to serve along side fellow parishioners!

Find something that speaks to your heart, and in the humble Spirit of St. Francis and St. Clare, serve your neighbor or community. The Peace Prayer reminds us that "It is in giving that we receive; it is in pardoning that we are pardoned; and it is in dying that we are born to eternal life." May we serve willingly, give generously, and receive with glad hearts the blessing of our Holy Father, St. Francis of Assisi!



Box of Joy: We will bless children suffering from extreme poverty by filling boxes with toys and other gifts, sharing the joy of Christmas and planting seeds of hope through the Gospel. Boxes can be picked up beginning October 1st in the Parish Office, after registration.

Nut Free Candy Collection: October 11/12 at all Masses. St. Mary's is partnering with a school in Paterson to provide a fun Trunk -or- Treat experience to children in need (see below). Candy that is being collected will be used for that event.

Heifer International / Fill The Ark Calendars: "Fill the Ark" is a four-week family devotional with a focus on gratitude for our blessings and a generous spirit of giving to our neighbors in need. Each week shares a scripture as the focus for reflection and study. Daily giving challenges bring parents, siblings, grandparents, or other family members together to appreciate their abundance and collect change to help struggling families. Calendars will be available in the church.

Pack-a-Meal for Bridges Outreach: Join us on October 15th at 6:30 p.m. in Spina Hall as we pack sustainable meals and make peanut butter and jelly sandwiches for those experiencing food insecurities. Please register for this event; all children must be accompanied by an adult. Families welcome!

The Bridges Organization aims to end homelessness through street outreach and intensive case management focusing on health, housing, and independence. Bridges forms relationships with those experiencing homelessness while meeting their most urgent needs. St Mary's volunteers will distribute food and emergency items to individuals, helping to make a connection with those who are on the margins and underserved.

Bridges Outreach Food Distribution: Join us on October 16th from 6-10 p.m. as we distribute brown bag lunches, hygiene kits, and other essential items in Rahway, NJ. You will help with set up, item distribution, and clean up while engaging with patrons on our mission to end homelessness. Open to parishioners 18 and older, High School-aged volunteers must be accompanied by a parent. Please register for this event; spots are limited.

Adult Volunteer & Minister Appreciation Dinner: For all you do for St. Mary's! October 24th at 7:00 p.m. in the Carnevale Center. If you volunteer for one of our ministries, please register on our website so we can show our appreciation.

Trunk-or-Treat in the parking lot at Paterson Arts and Science Charter School on October 25th from 2-4 p.m. This is a great family activity! All vehicles are welcome and must complete a registration form prior to the event. Trunk or Treating is open to Paterson students only. St. Mary's Families are encouraged to dress up and enjoy the experience of handing out candy to children in need. "Trunkers" will be asked to decorate their trunk, tailgate, or hatchback and provide nut-free candy for 100 "Treaters". St. Mary's will provide additional candy from the candy collection. Please register for this event!

Market Street Mission: Join us on November 1st from 9-11:30 am. on the Morristown Green as we partner with Market Street Mission to distribute coats, hats, gloves, and scarves to those who are in need. Please register for this event; spots are limited. Anyone under 18 must be accompanied by an adult.

St. Francis Inn: Join us on November 8th as we travel to Philadelphia to work with the St. Francis Inn, feeding the unhoused and those who have food insecurities. This trip is open to those in high school and older. Anyone under 18 must be accompanied by an adult. Please register for this all-day event. The St. Francis Inn is a Franciscan, Eucharistic community called to minister with the poor and homeless of Philadelphia. Formed in the spirit of the Gospel and inspired by the life and compassion of Francis and Clare of Assisi, we try to meet the immediate daily needs of the people we serve with food, clothing, and hospitality. Our restaurant-style soup kitchen, open 365 days a year! Our mission is to not only feed the hungry, but also provide essential toiletry products and a safe place to receive mail. Volunteers typically help seat, serve, and bus a meal service. We may help with Meal preparation, or assist in Marie's closet, the clothing distribution center. We will be there to serve however we can for the day.






