


**EMMAUS RETREAT

Saint Mary's Youth Ministry is offering its annual Emmaus Retreat, from February 27th-March 1st.

This retreat experience gives our high schoolers a great opportunity to continue growing in their faith while also developing their own faith community. It will be taking place at Camp Shiloh in Hewitt, NJ, and all high school-aged students are welcome to attend!



We will be blessing throats in honor of St. Blaise at the Daily Mass on February 3rd and after all the Masses on February 7th and 8th.

We know more about the devotion to Saint Blaise by Christians around the world than we know about the saint himself.

According to the Acts of St. Blaise (written 400 years after his death), we know that Bishop Blaise was martyred in his episcopal city of Sebastea, Armenia, in 316. During his life, Blaise was a good bishop, working hard to encourage the spiritual and physical health of his people. Due to religious persecution, he was forced to flee to the back country of Armenia. There, he lived as a hermit in solitude and prayer, while making friends with wild animals. One day a group of hunters stumbled upon Blaise's cave and were surprised and then frightened to find the bishop kneeling in prayer surrounded by patiently waiting wolves, lions and bears.

The legend has it that as these hunters hauled Blaise off to prison, a mother came with her young son who had a fish bone lodged in his throat. At Blaise's command the child was able to cough up the bone.

Through the intercession of St. Blaise, bishop and martyr, may God deliver us from every disease of the throat and from every other illness!





MEMORIAL OPPORTUNITIES

We have several ways that you can remember your loved ones at St. Mary's.

- **Mass intentions:** Mass intentions are listed in the bulletin and announced during Mass. Suggested offerings is \$20 for both weekday Masses and weekend Masses.
- **Bread and Wine:** This offering covers the cost of the bread and wine we use during the week. This offering is listed in the bulletin and announced at weekend Masses. Suggested offering is \$35.
- **Altar Flowers:** This offering covers the cost of the flowers on the altar during the week. This offering is listed in the bulletin and announced at weekend Masses. Suggested offering is \$50.
- **Vigil Lights:** Vigil Lights are the candles in the vestibule of the church which burn for one year. A small plaque can be placed on the candle commemorating your loved one. Offering is \$100 for one year (with the option to renew every year) and \$25 to engrave the plaque. We currently have 3 vigil lights available.
- **Paving Stones:** You can have a stone with your loved one's name placed in our prayer garden which will remain in perpetuity and be cleaned on a regular basis. Stones are \$350. Please be aware that it may take several months for your stone to be engraved and placed.
- **Tree of Life:** In the vestibule of the church, you will see our Tree of Life, which has the names of people who have died. Leaves are \$500 and stones are \$1,000.

SEEK SUPPORT FROM US

Baptismal Aftercare: We prepare joyful gift packages of prayer cards, care booklets, special items, and handmade items made with love from St. Mary's Hearts and Hands ministry. The gift packages are presented to the families at the Baptism of their children.

Bereavement Support Group: We offer comfort and community to those grieving the loss of a loved one. Join us for a time of sharing, prayer, and healing in a safe, supportive space through Pathways Counseling Center.

Consolation Ministry: We send cards of condolences to the families who have lost a loved one and have made arrangements with St. Mary's for church, funeral home or graveside services. The card includes information for additional help, if needed, through the Stephen Ministry and/or Pathways Services.

English Language Learning: We provide classes to adult immigrants from various backgrounds (non-denominational) and countries. Classes provide immigrants an opportunity to learn to speak, comprehend, read and write English, as well as learn about our history and customs.

Hearts & Hands Ministry: We get together to crochet and knit at all levels. We encourage anyone who would like to learn to knit or crochet to attend one of our gatherings.

Homebound Connections: We provide a social connection to individuals who could benefit from a personal visit. Visits are made to residences, nursing facilities and other home situations of parish members.

Lost Angels: We are a bereavement/support group for families and loved ones who have lost someone to addiction/overdose.

More Than Ever: We are a ministry of healing for parents and grandparents that are estranged from their children or grandchildren.

Pathways Counseling Center: We are a state-sanctioned mental health center offering professional counseling to children, adults and families. We accept most major commercial health insurances in addition to Medicare and Medicaid.

Prayer Shawl: We are a group who knit and crochet prayer shawls which we gift to members of the St. Mary's extended community who are in need of comfort and prayer.

Stephen Ministry: We are highly trained Stephen Ministers meet with and provide emotional and spiritual support to those facing life challenges like grief, divorce, dealing with illness, or any other serious issue.


