Beyond The Days:

A Lenten Journey of Identity, Encounter and Transformation

Sunday, March 1st at 7:00 p.m.

Monday, March 2nd and Tuesday, March 3rd: abbreviated mission after noon Mass with the full mission at 7:00 p.m.

*Our parish will embark on a mission that leads us to the very heart of Christian life. Through preaching at all Sunday Masses and three evening presentations, **Fr. Ricky Manalo, CSP**, will guide us into a deeper understanding of who we are, what we celebrate, and how God continues to transform us through sacred time, worship, and the way we live together as Church.*

This Lent, our parish invites you to journey to the very heart of Christian life. Fr. Ricky Manalo, CSP, Ph.D.—Paulist priest, composer, theologian, and missionary—will preach at all Sunday Masses and lead three evening presentations designed to deepen our faith and renew our sense of what it means to be Church together.

Sunday Fr. Ricky will preach at all Masses, offering a vision and invitation for the week ahead.

Sunday Evening *Who Are We?* We explore the Lenten and Easter seasons as the spiritual core of our year—the great "90 days" that tell the story of our Christian identity and call us to ongoing conversion. More than a calendar, this sacred time is an invitation to remember who we truly are: a people claimed by God, marked by baptism, and called to walk together toward the light of Easter.

Monday Evening *What Do We Celebrate?* We reflect on the Eucharist as the sacred threshold where heaven and earth meet, and where we are continually formed, re-formed, and transformed in Christ as one Body. The Mass is not simply something we attend—it is something we become. Each time we gather at the table of the Lord, we are shaped more deeply into the Body of Christ we receive.

Tuesday Evening *How Do We Live Together?* Perhaps no question feels more urgent in our time than this one. We live in a world deeply divided—by politics, by culture, by fear, and sometimes even by faith. These divisions do not stop at the church door. They find their way into our families, our friendships, and our pews. How do we move forward together?

Attending a parish mission is a wonderful way to invigorate your faith during Lent. In doing so, you are giving of your time—the most precious commodity we have. You are engaging in prayer with your community, growing closer to God, and supporting the important work of Fr. Ricky Manalo. This is Lent lived together, not alone. Please join us for this Lenten Mission.

This mission is an invitation to slow down, listen more deeply, and enter the Paschal Mystery with renewed faith and hope. Fr. Ricky is the 2018 Pastoral Musician of the Year (NAPM), a theological consultant for the USCCB, and co-chair of The Communion Project, which addresses political depolarization in the Church and society. His compositions include *Spirit and Grace*, *Many and Great*, and *Beyond the Days*.

All are welcome.

Misión Parroquial con el P. Ricky Manalo, CSP

Domingo, 1 de marzo: 7:00 p.m.

Esta Cuaresma, nuestra parroquia los invita a emprender un camino hacia el corazón mismo de la vida cristiana. El P. Ricky Manalo, CSP, Ph.D.—sacerdote paulista, compositor, teólogo y misionero—predicará en todas las Misas del domingo y dirigirá tres presentaciones vespertinas diseñadas para profundizar nuestra fe y renovar nuestra comprensión de lo que significa ser Iglesia juntos.

Domingo El P. Ricky predicará en todas las Misas, ofreciendo una visión e invitación para la semana que comienza.

Domingo por la noche *¿Quiénes somos?* Exploraremos los tiempos de Cuaresma y Pascua como el núcleo espiritual de nuestro año—los grandes "90 días" que narran la historia de nuestra identidad cristiana y nos llaman a una conversión continua. Más que un calendario, este tiempo sagrado es una invitación a recordar quiénes somos verdaderamente: un pueblo elegido por Dios, marcado por el bautismo y llamado a caminar juntos hacia la luz de la Pascua.

Lunes por la noche *¿Qué celebramos?* Reflexionaremos sobre la Eucaristía como el umbral sagrado donde el cielo y la tierra se encuentran, y donde somos continuamente formados, reformados y transformados en Cristo como un solo Cuerpo. La Misa no es simplemente algo a lo que asistimos—es algo en lo que nos convertimos. Cada vez que nos reunimos en la mesa del Señor, somos configurados más profundamente en el Cuerpo de Cristo que recibimos.

Martes por la noche *¿Cómo vivimos juntos?* Quizás ninguna pregunta se siente más urgente en nuestro tiempo que esta. Vivimos en un mundo profundamente dividido—por la política, la cultura, el miedo y, a veces, incluso por la fe. Estas divisiones no se detienen en la puerta de la iglesia. Se abren camino en nuestras familias, nuestras amistades y nuestros bancos. ¿Cómo avanzamos juntos?

Participar en una misión parroquial es una manera maravillosa de revitalizar la fe durante la Cuaresma. Al hacerlo, estamos dando nuestro tiempo—el bien más precioso que tenemos. Nos unimos en oración con nuestra comunidad, nos acercamos más a Dios y apoyamos el importante trabajo del P. Ricky Manalo. Esta es la Cuaresma vivida juntos, no en soledad. Los invitamos a acompañarnos en esta Misión Cuaresmal.

Esta misión es una invitación a detenernos, escuchar más profundamente y entrar en el Misterio Pascual con fe y esperanza renovadas. El P. Ricky fue nombrado Músico Pastoral del Año 2018 por la Asociación Nacional de Músicos Pastorales (NAPM), es consultor teológico de la Conferencia de Obispos Católicos de los Estados Unidos (USCCB) y copreside El Proyecto Comunión, que trabaja por la despolarización política en la Iglesia y la sociedad. Entre sus composiciones se encuentran *Spirit and Grace*, *Many and Great* y *Beyond the Days*.



Lenten Disciplines of Fasting & Abstinence

Catholics in good health ages 18 to 59 are required to fast and to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.

Fasting consists of eating only one meal, with the possibility of two smaller snacks that do not add up to a single full meal.

Catholics age 14 and older are to abstain from meat on all Fridays in Lent.

From the Parish Council



Over the past two years, the Parish Council has been hard at work. After analyzing the results of the parish survey, we realized that one of the most pressing concerns was to draw younger families to the church. We're happy to report that we have made significant progress in that area. We have ramped up our monthly family liturgy, with more and more families attending the 10:30 a.m. Mass on the first Sunday of the month. We've added a very successful Children's Liturgy of the Word Program to our 9:00 Mass--each week up to 30 children step out of Mass for 20 minutes to hear a child-friendly version of the Gospel and accompanying craft. We had a fun and well-attended outdoor tailgate Mass to kick off our Middle School Religious Education Program, Dorothy Limey has taken on the role of Parish Life Coordinator to fill our year with more family-friendly activities to draw and keep more families to our wonderful parish. We are very happy with the progress we've made, and look forward to more programs like this in the future.

Over the next few months, we're going to turn our attention to our high school and young adult parishioners. We're fortunate that our youth ministry program is very robust. Thanks to the work of Trevor George, Nicole George (no relation!), and Cathy Feld, and a wonderful group of volunteers, our high school students are learning and living out their faith. We confirmed almost 120 high school students in the faith in February, our retreats are well attended and generate a lot of excitement, and we have dozens of young people attending our movie night each week. We plan on building upon this great foundation to think about what more we can do to help our young people discover Christ. We also planning on looking at ways that we can enhance the experience of our young adults, building on the work of Zach George and Catie Saint-Jacques.

In an effort to keep our Parish Council brimming with new ideas, we will be rotating people in and out of this important advisory board. At this time, we say farewell to Diana Angeles, whose hard work and insight--especially in light of her experience with the Hispanic Ministry--were so helpful. We also welcome Bobby Jenkin and Andrea Piccirillo and look forward to their contributions in the years to come!




