

# MESSAGE FROM FR. MATT

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

A few years ago, during the time when everything was shut down and we all spent a lot of time at home, I watched a ton of Marvel movies. There are great characters in these movies. Captain America, the Hulk, Thor, Captain Marvel, and many more. My favorite Marvel character is Peter Quill, also known as Star Lord. I think the reason that I like this character so much is because he is both heroic and really funny. He has a swagger to him, but he is also humble. There is a moment at the end of the first Guardians of the Galaxy

movie where everything seems lost. Evil seems to have won. But then, suddenly, Peter and his crew, in a very funny way, defeat the bad guy and save the world. Peter, in this last desperate moment, realizes that he is more than just a funny guy trying to do good. He is more than he, or anyone else, thought he was.

When I was a sophomore in college, barely seeing the field on Saturdays, my coaches called me in and asked me to play a position, fullback, that I had never played. I was stunned. That wasn't who I was. My coaches told me to think about it and ask my dad what he thought. My dad said, "play whatever they ask you to play."



In the Readings for this week, we meet three people who thought that they knew who they were. Isaiah, Paul and Peter. When asked to challenge their beliefs about themselves, none of the three thought that what they were being asked to become was possible. They were sinners. They were unworthy. In this they were correct. But there was another person involved; the one asking them.

There are two things going on in each of these cases. First, what Isaiah, Paul and Peter didn't realize at the moment that God first asks them, is that God was going to provide for them, and what God would provide, His Grace, would be enough. Second, God knew them better than they knew themselves. God saw something in Isaiah that told Him that Isaiah could be the greatest and most prolific prophet the world would see until the time of John the Baptist. God saw that Paul, who was fighting so violently against His Church, could fight heroically on behalf of the Faith, and become the Faith's greatest and most prolific teacher. God saw that Peter, a hard worker, a team player, a humble man, with strong but imperfect faith, could become the leader, the Rock upon which He built His Church.

What do you think God thinks of you? If you are very certain, I encourage you to question that. I would bet that some of us are a lot more than we think we are, and some of us are a little less than we think that we are, but what matters most is what God knows we are. Like Isaiah, Paul and Peter, let's be humble about this before God. Let God tell you who you are. Let's also let God tell us what we can do. Things might seem like too much for us, but what we learn in the Readings today is that it is not all up to us. If we are open to it, God's Grace will be with us, whatever we face, and God's Grace will be sufficient. It will be enough.

It isn't often that we actually ask ourselves the question, "Who am I?" Ask it this week, but not just to yourself, ask it of God. I think that you are going to find, like Peter Quill in the Guardians movie did, and like Isaiah, Paul and Peter did, that you aren't exactly who you think you are. God knows you better than you know yourself so trust His answer. Ask yourself another question; "What am I supposed to do?" God may ask you to do something really difficult, much more difficult than playing fullback! You may not think that you can do it. Do whatever God asks of you. You don't have to run away from hardship. You aren't alone. God will give you the Grace that you need to do it.



reflection on the events of the day in order to detect God's presence and discern his direction for us. The Examen is an ancient practice in the Church that can help us see God's hand at work in our whole experience. This is a version of the five-step Daily Examen that St. Ignatius practiced.

- $\Rightarrow$  Become aware of God's presence.
- $\Rightarrow$  Review the day with gratitude.
- $\Rightarrow$  Pay attention to your emotions.
- ⇒ Choose one feature of the day & pray from it.
- ⇒ Look toward tomorrow.


