

From the Desk of Fr John

1. My recent holidays

I had a wonderful time away in the Canary Islands. The Canary Islands, located off the coast of Morocco, are part of Spain and are very safe! Rev. John Johnson, currently Associate Pastor of the clustered parishes of Holy Angels and St. Anne, St. Thomas and Rev. Mark Maloney, currently Parochial Vicar of St. Justin, London, have been appointed Associate Pastors of the Family."

So, Families of Parishes are coming! One step we have taken, is that we have already moved to a common website for our Family (a work in progress). The Parish Pastoral Council and the Parish Team will be dealing with this issue and will be looking at ways that will help us prepare for the implementation of our Family - St. Mary's, Tillsonburg, Sacred Heart, Langton and St. Michael's, Walsh.
