From Colleen ...

While I was on retreat I had the opportunity to sit down and watch one of my favourite movies with a dear friend called "Return to Me". It is a beautiful movie about truth and sacrifice. Carroll O'Connor plays a loving Irish grandfather and in the movie he says to his granddaughter (played by Minnie Driver) "It's the character that is the strongest that God gives the most challenges to. Take your struggles as a compliment." I have watched this movie many times and this time those words resonated very deeply in me; I never considered my struggles as a compliment. If I could choose one theme from the readings this weekend it would be how each reading presents some sort of struggle. This weekend we hear of Jeremiah's struggle as a prophet in the first reading, the author of the book of Hebrews expresses the peoples' struggle with "every weight and the sin that clings so closely" and in the Gospel even Jesus mentions his own stress he is under "to bring fire to the earth" and to complete the "baptism to which (he is) to be baptized!"

We are a people who struggle in our faith, in our family life, in our work, in the every day choices and decisions we make. For me, my greatest struggle is with change – whether I am the agent of the change or the target of change. Someone once said to me the only person that likes change is a wet baby and I would agree! Carl Jung wrote "Change is the essence of life. Be willing to surrender what you are for what you can become." Our readings all point to this idea of surrender or sacrifice as a pivotal point in struggle – each of them reminding us that our struggle is not ours alone; we need to look outside of our struggle for help. Fr. Ron Rolheiser defined sacrifice like this: "To make a sacrifice is to surrender something out of love, something that is ours and is painful to give away, and to let the pain of that surrender stretch and change our hearts in such a way that we are now more open to communion with God and others." Our greatest role model in struggle, in change and in sacrifice is Jesus. To be honest I have come to admire this Gospel – Jesus is stressed, he knows what He wants to accomplish, but knows that it will be a difficult struggle. He knows that there will be division and it will require the greatest sacrifice – death on the cross. "Consider Jesus who endured such hostility against himself from sinners, so that you may not grow weary or lose heart." (Heb. 12:3) So my friends as we persevere and run the race, let's meet our struggles head on with Jesus in our hearts and in our minds.
