HOW DO I BECOME CATHOLIC?

The process of becoming a mature Christian involves more than just learning about the faith of the Church. The RCIA aims to transform the entire person into an individual who has truly put on Christ Jesus.

Pyxes Needed!

If you have borrowed a pyx (small round gold container) to take communion to a family member during the pandemic, or if you have taken communion to a neighbour or friend prior to the pandemic, and no longer are doing so, I would ask that you return your pyx to the office as soon as possible. Since our Reach Out teams cannot visit because of COVID protocols, many family members who are in the same household or bubble as a primary caregiver have stepped up to share the Blessed Sacrament with their loved ones. Unfortunately, we no longer have any extra pyxes at the parishes to enable this. You can place your borrowed pyx you no longer are using in an envelope, write PYX RETURN on the envelope and slide it through the mail slot at our main office at 51 Venison St. W. Tillsonburg.
