A message from Father Kevin about giving

During these difficult times many are being affected financially, including your parish. Many are out of work and having to trust somehow God will provide for them. Let us keep those who are out of work in our prayers. The parish is also affected by all this, which is why I ask that those who have the financial means to do so, please consider helping the parish the best you can (others who cannot, please help the parish by praying for the parish as well during this pandemic). If you can help financially, you can give in several ways: online giving (simply go to our parish website to learn how to set that up); drop off your donation in the black mailbox outside the parish office, or mail in your donation to the parish: Our Lady of Mount Carmel Parish, 984 Taunton Ave., PO Box 519, Seekonk, MA 02771. Every little bit helps. As this pandemic continues, there may be some decisions about where adjustments or cuts will need to be made, so I ask for your prayers that I will carry those decisions out wisely and that it will be what is best for the parish at this time.

Sign up for Flocknote for parish messages

By now you should have received a letter about a new way of communication for the parish called Flocknote. It allows the parish to reach out to everyone via text or email to update them on different things going on. We are not getting rid of email, the bulletin, the website, or our Facebook site, but is a very effective way we can reach people. To sign up, you can text OLMCSeekonk to 84576, and choose the way you want things made known to you (email or text). We can use it for general announcements, and groups within the parish can use it. Parishes using it have found it has helped parishioners become more familiar with parish life and has increased the response to parish activities.

New hours for parish office

Adjusted office hours are Monday to Thursday, 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. Two of the main staff will check voice messages and emails on these days. Most of the work that needs to get done can be accomplished over the phone. If you need to drop off anything or to pick up needed paperwork, this will be placed in the drop box we installed outside the parish office, or mailed to you.

Pastor's Page

The Wild Goose: We are beginning a parish-wide study called "The Wild Goose" which is all about the Holy Spirit. It should help us prepare well for the experience of Pentecost at the end of the Easter season, as well help us grow in the awareness of how the Holy Spirit works in our lives. All are encouraged to join us! The videos can be found at olmcseekonk.formed.org (you must register for a free account). You are encouraged to watch two short videos a week, and then join us virtually for a weekly discussion. There will be two times for virtual discussion. Please pick the one that works best for your schedule: **Wednesdays at 7 p.m.** or **Sundays at 1 p.m.** The first discussion begins next week (April 22 or April 26). Livestreaming: Those who are trying to figure out how to watch the livestreamed Masses and other events we are doing, you can join the Our Lady of Mount Carmel Parish Seekonk Facebook site and watch the livestream. If you do not want to sign up for Facebook, you can also go to our parish website, olmcseekonk.org and click on the image under "Follow Us on Facebook" and it will connect you. You may also select the "F" for Facebook in the upper right corner of the page. It will ask you to login, but simply scroll down the page below the login and you can still watch the livestream.

Divine Mercy Sunday: This Sunday, April 19, at 2:30 p.m. (originally, I listed 3 p.m. as the start time, but we are going to start at 2:30 so we can pray the chapel at 3) we will livestream the praying of a holy hour for Divine Mercy Sunday.


Many Thanks: Many thanks to all of you for your kindness and support over the last month, especially during the

Triduum. Also, many thanks for the donations many of you have been making to the parish in this time. I pray the Lord will continue to strengthen all of you in the midst of all these trials.

Outdoor Stations of the Cross: We are setting up outside, in the main parking lot, a temporary Stations of the Cross that you can drive up to. It should be ready before Palm Sunday. Simply pull into the entrance of the parking lot, then turn left into the largest lot, and the first station will be immediately on the left. You drive around the lot clockwise and it conclude at the end of that first section. You can walk around to pray (as long as there are not many others around), but it is being set up so you can drive up to each station and view it from the driver's side of the car.

Confessions: Because of the directive from the bishop, we are not to have scheduled Confessions during this time. But that does not mean we cannot offer Confessions. Anyone who needs Confession, whatever the reason, should contact me at the office so we can arrange a time for the sacrament. If you are homebound and cannot get out for Confessions, if it is possible to arrange it at your home (maybe me standing outside and you inside at a window) where the privacy and confidentiality can still be carried out (and yet both be protected from any threat of passing on any possible virus) then I can come to you. So please call the rectory at 508-336-9022. You do not need to give your name but just simply tell me you want Confession and we can arrange a time (and if you get the voice mail please leave a message that you want Confession and your phone number and what might be the best time so if we play phone tag we can still schedule them).

Flocknote: A new way of communication for the parish is called Flocknote. To sign up, text OLMCSeekonk to 84576. Flocknote allows the parish to


reach out to everyone via text or email

If you are sick and in the hospital

If you are facing grave illness or going in for surgery at which they will be giving you anesthesia, please let Fr. Kevin know so he can come give you Confession, the Anointing of the Sick, and Communion (but only for a person who is dying, called Viaticum). Please know if you are admitted to the hospital for grave health, you should let them know that you are Catholic and would like the Anointing of the Sick or Confession (and please let your family know, if for some reason you are admitted to the hospital and unable to communicate, so your family can convey your wishes to the hospital). Currently at Rhode Island Hospital there is a priest chaplain, but some hospitals such as Sturdy do not have priest chaplains anymore, so ask them to contact Fr. Kevin, since you are a parishioner of Our Lady of Mount Carmel.
