

# PASTOR'S PAGE

Dear Parishioners,

Today we conclude the Christmas Season with the celebration of the Baptism of the Lord and tomorrow we begin Ordinary Time. Jesus did not need baptism but said to John the Baptist that it was necessary for him to be baptized. Theologians say the Lord did it to show us the path that is necessary for us. In this great event the Trinity is manifested by the voice of God the Father and the descent of Holy Spirit upon Jesus in the form of a dove.

Baptism is necessary for our salvation (The New Testament makes it clear it is necessary for us to have eternal life in heaven). By this great sacrament we are made children of God and members of the Church. We also receive sanctifying grace, become temples of the Holy Spirit, and are cleansed of original sin. The Church sees the sacrament as so important that even infants who do not understand the sacrament should be baptized as soon as possible after their birth. You will not find baptism of infants spoken of in the Scriptures, but we know it was being done in the early Church (we know it from one of the oldest documents in the Church called The Apostolic Tradition [approx. 215 A.D.] which speaks about baptizing infants). The parents make that act of faith on their baby's behalf and as their child receives the great gift of faith the parents promise to the Lord they will do all they can to foster the child's faith). The parent must show there is a reasonable hope the child will be raised in the faith.

This is also why we have godparents. A godparent represents the Catholic Church testifying that they will do all they can to help the parents in raising

their child in the practice of the faith. Because they are representing the Church, in the Code of Canon Law the Catholic Church says there must be certain qualifications for a godparent: they must have received the full initiation of the faith (Baptism, Eucharist, and Confirmation); they are living their lives in accordance with the teachings of the Church (for example: they are faithfully practicing their Catholic faith with Mass every Sunday and holy day, if married they are married sacramentally in the Church, they are not living in any immoral situation, etc.); and they are at least 16 years old (this deals with the question of maturity). The Church does allow for one godparent and another witness called a Christian Witness (they are not a godparent but are recorded as an official witness of the baptism and they are someone who was baptized as a Christian - they cannot be Catholic who doesn't qualify as a godparent nor can they be someone who was Catholic that joined some other Christian denomination later).

At Our Lady of Mount Carmel, if you are looking to baptize your baby (it is best to try to line these things up before one's child is born) then one should talk to someone about being godparent. You need at least one godparent but you can have two godparents (if there are two one must be male and the other female). The people you ask to be godparents will need to talk to the priest in their parish they currently belong about the priest signing a sponsor form that says they qualify as a godparent. Please do not ask someone who may not qualify because it ends up putting the priest or deacon in a bad position of telling them they don't qualify (even though they may be a very nice person and a great friend or relative but please remember this is about having someone who models the faith for you and your child). Once you have the sponsor form from the godparent or godparents then contact the office about scheduling the baptism (which we offer every Sunday at 12:00PM). If you need a sponsor form signed because you have been asked about being a godparent or

sponsor for confirmation then please contact the office.

Come join us for a **Holy Hour for Reparation and Healing for the Anniversary of Roe vs. Wade**. On Sunday, January 23rd there will be a holy hour for reparation for and healing from abortion, in the church, from 3:00PM - 4:00PM. This is the 48th Anniversary since the legalization of abortion by the Supreme Court decision Roe v. Wade. Please come join us in prayer for reparation for the evil of tens of millions of abortion in our country and prayers for healing for all those affected by abortion.

Will you consider participating in **The Vianney Group of Priestly Support, Monthly Day of Prayer & Fasting for our Priests?** The next monthly day of prayer and fasting for our priests will be Thursday, January 20th, 2022. In addition to the commitment of fasting that day, the Rosary and Divine Mercy Chaplet will be prayed at 3:00PM via zoom from the Chancery Chapel. There will be a gathering beginning at 5:30PM at Holy Ghost Church (recently known as St. Vincent DePaul, 71 Linden Street) in Attleboro for prayer. At 6:00PM there will then be a peaceful march for 1.5 miles to St. John the Evangelist Church in Attleboro (133 North Main St.) where it will conclude with Praise and Worship. Last year was their first year and they gathered up to 500 people. Let's do our part and help out in giving witness to the sanctity of life and the evils of abortion, if you can, please join us for the March in Attleboro.

Let us pray for all married couples, in particular this month for our parishioners Robert and Carol Bertoncini for the gift of the bond of marriage.




## 100<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of Our Lady of Mount Carmel Parish
