




Saint of the Week

The history of St. Conrad of Piacenza is quite fascinating. A member of one of the most noble families of Piacenza, he was known for his utmost honesty. One day while out hunting with friends, he thought he saw some game in an area of brush and ordered his attendants to set fire to the brush in order to scare it out of hiding. Unfortunately, the dry brush quickly ignited, and fire started to spread. Soon, the surrounding area was engulfed in flames.

Unfortunately, a known arsonist happened to be in the same area as the fire. This man was later imprisoned, tried, and condemned to death for the damage. But on his way to his execution, St. Conrad of Piacenza, full of guilt, stopped the proceedings and confessed to the fire. To make res-titution for the damages, Conrad had to sell all his belongings, which reduced him to poverty. Soon after, he decided to retire to a hermitage, where he became a hermit of the Third Order of St. Francis, and his wife entered the Order of Poor Clares.

If these hours do not work for you please contact me to schedule a particular time for confession. To help maintain a safe way for confessions in the midst of COVID, there is the ceiling vent running, as well as a fan, and window open in the confessional so there is air movement. When going to confession, one should still wear a mask in the confessional and one should sit in the chair next to the confessional screen (the screen is covered to help avoid the danger of any close face to face conversation).

After one goes to Confession, please use the sanitizing wipes to wipe the arms of the chair for the next person. For the time being there will not be face to face confession, only thru the confessional screen.



Receiving Low Gluten Eucharist

For those of you who may have a gluten allergy, we do have in the sacristy low gluten hosts that can be consecrated into the Eucharist. If that is something you need please speak to Fr. Kevin so arrangements can be made to receive them at Mass (before Mass we can set aside a particular pyx for those with low gluten allergy so as not to be affected by the gluten in the regular hosts). For those receiving the low gluten hosts, after talking to Fr. Kevin before Mass so he knows who is going to be receiving the low gluten hosts, you should come up in the communion line approaching Fr. Kevin and he will have the low gluten hosts (he will purify his fingers in water just before you receive so there is no danger of particles from the regular hosts being passed on to the low gluten hosts).
