

# PASTOR'S PAGE

Dear Parishioners,

**The Holy Trinity Sunday!** This Sunday we celebrate Holy Trinity Sunday. This is the very mystery of God Himself. This is more than celebrating the existence of God, or the attributes of God (such as all knowing; all merciful; all powerful; etc.), or actions of God (such as creating, redeeming, or sanctifying). This celebration today is about the core of who God is: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Each Person is fully God (yet only One God) yet distinct, and has been and will be forever the essential reality of God. God for all eternity has been and forever will be One God, yet within God eternally relational, therefore eternal love. For all eternity, the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit have perfectly loved one another. This is why it is so important for us to grow in the love of God as fully as we can, we have to work at our relationship with each Person of the Trinity. As we work at growing in our relationship with each person of the Trinity, if we let them they always lead us to deeper love of the other Persons, as well as love for our neighbor. The mystery of the Trinity must be accepted for Christians to be Christian. But two prayers that can help deepen our understanding and love for the Trinity are: 1.) the Trisagion Angelum and 2.) The Athanasian Creed (also called the "Quicumque" was attributed to St. Athanasius who writes about the many distinctions we make about the Trinity which are very important). Taking its name from St. Athanasius (373 A.D.), even though it is no longer attributed to him, this prayer enumerates the essential doctrine of Christianity, especially the mysteries of the Holy Trinity. St. Teresa of Avila recounts a meditation on this creed as follows: "Once, when I was reciting the *Quicumque vult*, I was shown so clearly how it was possible for there to be One God alone and Three Persons, that it caused me both amazement and much comfort. It was of the greatest help in teaching me to know more of the greatness of God and his marvels."

The Athanasian Creed: "Whoever wishes to be saved, needs above all to hold the Catholic faith; unless each one preserves this whole and inviolate, he will without a doubt perish in eternity. But the Catholic faith is this, that we venerate one God in the Trinity, and the Trinity in oneness; neither confounding the persons, nor dividing the

substance; for there is one person of the Father, another of the Son, and another of the Holy Spirit; but the divine nature of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit is one, their glory is equal, their majesty is coeternal.

Of such a nature as the Father is, so is the Son, so also is the Holy Spirit; the Father is uncreated, the Son is uncreated, and the Holy Spirit is uncreated; the Father is infinite, the Son is infinite, and the Holy Spirit is infinite; the Father is eternal, the Son is eternal, and the Holy Spirit is eternal; and nevertheless there are not three eternals but one eternal; just as there are not three uncreated beings, nor three infinite beings, but one uncreated, and one infinite; similarly the Father is almighty, the Son is almighty, and the Holy Spirit is almighty; and yet there are not three almighty's but one almighty; thus the Father is God, the Son is God, and the Holy Spirit is God; and nevertheless there are not three gods, but there is one God; so the Father is Lord, the Son is Lord, and the Holy Spirit is Lord; and yet there are not three lords, but there is one Lord; because just as we are compelled by Christian truth to confess singly each one person as God, and also Lord, so we are forbidden by the Catholic religion to say there are three gods or three Lords. The Father was not made, nor created, nor begotten by anyone. The Son is from the Father alone, not made nor created, but begotten. The Holy Spirit is from the Father and the Son, not made, nor created, nor begotten, but proceeding.

There is, therefore, one Father, not three Fathers; one Son, not three Sons; one Holy Spirit, not three Holy Spirits; and in this Trinity there is nothing first or later, nothing greater or less, but all three Persons are coeternal and coequal with one another, so that in every respect, as has already been said above, both unity in Trinity, and Trinity in unity must be venerated. Therefore, let him who wishes to be saved, think thus concerning the Trinity. But it is necessary for eternal salvation that he faithfully believes also the incarnation of our Lord Jesus Christ. Accordingly, it is the right faith, that we believe and confess, that our Lord Jesus Christ, the Son of God is God and man. He is God begotten of the substance of the Father before time, and He is man born of the substance of His mother in time: perfect God, perfect man, consisting of a rational soul and a human body, equal to the Father according to His Godhead, less than the Father according to humanity.

Although he is God and man, yet He is not two, but He is one Christ; one how-

ever, not by the conversion of the Divinity into a human body, but by the assumption of humanity in the Godhead; one absolutely not by confusion of substance, but by unity of person. For just as the rational soul and body are one man, so God and man are one Christ. He suffered for our salvation, descended into hell, on the third day arose again from the dead, ascended into heaven, sits at the right hand of God the Father Almighty; thence He shall come to judge the living and the dead; at His coming all men have to arise again with their bodies and will render an account of their own deeds: and those who have done good, will go into life everlasting, but those who have done evil, into eternal fire. This is the Catholic faith; unless everyone believes this faithfully and firmly, he cannot be saved. Amen."

**Congratulations to the three children who were baptized** last Sunday, June 5<sup>th</sup>. The three children were: *Kennedy J. Fortier, Summer R. Azulay, and Logan A. Wahl*. Please pray that the three of them will grow in their response to the great graces they received from the Lord through the sacraments. Pray they will know they are beloved children of God, members of the Church cleansed from original sin, and are temples of the Holy Spirit. Pray for their parents and godparents that they will be great instruments of fostering the faith God has given to their children. Also, please pray for the two boys who received their first communion last Sunday as well.

**Where are the newly ordained priests being assigned?** Last Saturday, June 4<sup>th</sup>, the Diocese of Fall River was blessed to have four men ordained to the priesthood: Matthew F. Laird, William J. O'Donnell, III, Gregory K. Quenneville and Laurent M. Valliere at St. Mary's Cathedral. Fr. Laird will be serving as parochial vicar at St. Joseph, Guardian of the Family in Falmouth. Fr. Valliere will be serving as parochial vicar at Our Lady of Victory in Centerville, as well as being chaplain at Pope St. John Paul II High School in Hyannis. Fr. O'Donnell will be serving at parochial vicar at St. Mary's Church in South Dartmouth. Fr. Quenneville will be assigned on Nantucket for the summer and then begin serving as parochial vicar at St. Julie Billiart in North Dartmouth in September.

Also, the diocese is offering an incentive award goal for each parish. Our average over the last three years was \$108,752.33, so with giving more than 5% of that (\$5,437.62), then if we raise \$114,189.95, the parish will receive .50 on each additional dollar.

## Receiving Low Gluten Eucharist

For those of you who may have a gluten allergy, we do have in the sacristy low gluten hosts that can be consecrated into the Eucharist. If that is something you need please speak to Fr. Kevin so arrangements can be made to receive them at Mass (before Mass we can set aside a particular pyx for those with low gluten allergy so as not to be affected by the gluten in the regular hosts).

For those receiving the low gluten hosts, after talking to Fr. Kevin before Mass so he knows who is going to be receiving the low gluten hosts, you should come up in the communion line approaching Fr. Kevin and he will have the low gluten hosts (he will purify his fingers in water just before you receive so there is no danger of particles from the regular hosts being passed on to the low gluten hosts).


