# PASTOR'S PAGE



Dear Parishioners,

As we celebrate Thanksgiving this week on Thanksgiving morning we will have Mass at 9:00AM (**we will not have our regular scheduled Thursday evening 6:30PM Mass that day**). But the Wednesday evening before Thanksgiving (November 23rd) at 7:00PM we will have a Mass of thanksgiving to God for all the blessings we have received from the Lord. At that Mass we will have some bins set out to collect any canned and dry goods people may be able to donate to give to our and other local food pantries. Hope you can join us!

**Remembering All Our Deceased Parishioners.** Last Friday, November 11th we celebrated a Mass for all our deceased parishioners from over the one hundred years of the parish. We do not have any records of the first three years of the parish about funerals, but since 1925 until November 1st of this year we have celebrated 2590 funerals of parishioners. It is striking to think about of 2590 everyone of them many loved them and grieved over them. For each one God was perfectly present to and offered them countless graces throughout their lives so they may live and die in the love of the Trinity and be in the glory of God forever. Let us continue to pray for all whomever is in need of God's cleansing mercy in Purgatory (especially if there are any fellow parishioners from over these years who are in Purgatory) so they may enter into the joy of heaven.

**Thinking about becoming Catholic?** The month of November is the time of the year we begin the Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults for those who are thinking becoming Catholic (or who are baptized Catholic but never received First Communion and Confirmation). **Please Save the Date** as we begin to approach the end of the liturgical year and approach the season of Advent, we once again will have our Novena for Our Lady of the Immaculate Conception. The novena will be held from November

30th - December 8th at 7:00PM in the church, during which every evening there will be Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, a talk by a different priest or deacon on a particular theme for the novena, the praying of the Rosary, an opportunity for Confession, and Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament. The theme for this year's novena is *learning from the lives of different saints of how to live the virtues after the heart of Christ*. The main purpose of the novena is to help us honor Our Lady and prepare spiritually for the great celebration of Our Lady of the Immaculate Conception on December 8th. The novena can be a way to not only deepen our love for Mary, but also help us enter into the Advent Season and help direct our hearts in a peaceful way during the craziness and stresses of preparing for Christmas.

**Anniversary Memorabilia to go on sale!** In early November we will have an order form made for different items marking the 100th anniversary of our parish that people can purchase (pens, mugs, insulated bottles, tote bags, journal, polo shirts, Sherpa blanket, and sweatshirts) and we will sell Christmas ornaments that mark this special anniversary.

Ron has manifested in many ways such a generous heart in serving the Lord and His Church through the pro-life work (the head of our parish pro-life group and coordinated the annual baby bottle collection; daily praying outside the abortion clinic in Attleboro and by that witnessed have helped many women see the gift of their baby); a member of the parish Finance Council; volunteers in so many different parish activities; and lectors at Mass; a member of prison ministry; and many other things. Thanks to Ron for his example and the actions of the love of Christ that he has shown in so many ways.

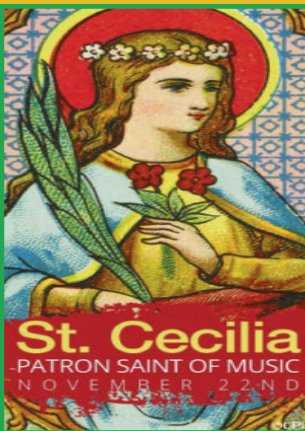

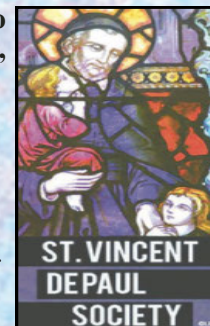

## Interested in attending the March for Life 2023?

Even with the Supreme Court overturning the national legalization of abortion, as we have seen in the reaction of so many thinking women have a right to abort their baby, we are reminded we have a long ways to go as a people to recognize the dignity of life from the moment of conception and cherish and protect the dignity of life. There are so many areas we have to work at helping people to recognize that dignity. One area is as a people to publicly march to proclaim life is sacred at the national March for Life in Washington D.C. January 19-21st.

1) Going by Flight: We are coordinating a group pilgrimage with others from other parishes in Dighton and Taunton. We will be flying to Washington on January 19th and flying back on the 21st. We will be staying at the Renaissance D.C. Downtown Hotel. The cost for the flight and two-night stay at the hotel varies on whether one wants to have a room to one self or if you want to have two, three, or four people to a room. One person

per room - \$500; Two people per room - \$285; three per room - \$210; and four per room \$175 per person. The cost does not include price of airport parking, Metro ticket, meals, or incidental expenses. A \$50 non-refundable deposit is due by October 31st (we must reserve our rooms by November 1st). We currently have 25 plane tickets reserved so the first 25 to sign up will have the costs as listed, but if we need to reserve more tickets then the costs for those who sign up after the 25th person could have their cost rise because plane ticket prices continue fluctuate daily so we may not be able to get tickets for the same price.

2) Going by Bus with the Diocese March for Life - The Pro-Life Office for the Diocese of Fall River is looking to organize a bus to travel to the March for Life in Washington, D.C. this January. All Attendees have to be 18+ for safe environment standards. Those registering should have a friend in mind that they wouldn't mind sharing a room with. The approximate cost per individual is going to be \$350. The trip would run Thursday, January 19, 2023 - Saturday, Janu-

ary 20, 2023. The trip includes: Two-night stay at the Double Tree by Hilton; Double Queen bed Room (shared); Friday and Saturday Breakfast; Mass at the Basilica of the Immaculate Conception; March for Life Rally & March; and round-trip transportation. Meals beyond breakfast are not covered. If you are interested please contact Deborah LeDoux at [www.dledoux@dioc-fr.org](mailto:www.dledoux@dioc-fr.org).

3) Going by Bus with Cape Cod Bus for Life - The Cape Cod Bus for Life is organizing a bus trip to the March for Life. They will be leaving from Massachusetts on Thursday, January 19th and returning on Saturday, January 21, 2023. The cost is \$300 per person if you plan to share a room - double occupancy. If you do not share a room with someone, and, are the only one in the room - single occupancy, the cost will be \$500. Please fill out the registration form. If you have more questions. 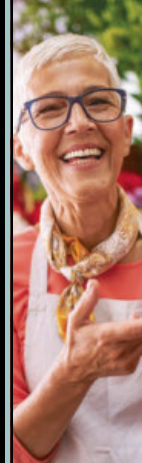
