## The Journey of Faith with Father Matthew Oakland

With King County entering Phase 2 today, we are excited that we are able to reopen for public Mass this weekend! Our Control, Mitigation and Recovery Business Plan is presently 42 pages long. Bishop Mueggenborg approved it Wednesday evening, and the staff and I have spent the last few days making all the necessary preparations for Masses this weekend. For three months, I can't count how many times I have said "We don't know." But that isn't the case anymore.

As you come to Mass, things are going to be different. The Front Doors will be open, but only for added ventilation. Everyone will enter by the side door, checking in at the registration table first. Everyone MUST sign up for Mass before arriving using [SignUp Genius](#) or by contacting the parish office 206-937-1488 x200 or [mtuthill@holyroaryseattle.org](mailto:mtuthill@holyroaryseattle.org)). To give everyone an opportunity to attend, we ask that you only sign up for one Mass every two weeks. However, if there are spots open for the weekend on Friday, feel free to sign up even if you came the week before.

When you sign up on SignUp Genius, always put a quantity of 1 for 1 Household, who you can be seated with without social distancing. In the comment section, list the names of those coming to help us as we assign seats to fit everyone in. Providing your phone number for possible future contact tracing is optional.

The call in/email list will close at 5PM Friday, and the online sign up will end by 9AM Saturday, when we create the seating chart for each Mass. With some trial and error, we know we can always get 45 households in given our variable seating options, about 100-125 people. Almost everyone will be seated at the end of a pew, all of which are labelled. When you arrive, you will be given your seat number. For example, "Row 4, Seat A." Just like an airplane, we have window seats (Seats A are near the stained glass windows off the alley and Seats D are near the stained glass windows along 42nd). We also have aisle seats—Seats B and C run down the middle. Hospitality Ministers will be available to direct you.

To open under the Governor's Order, everyone over the age of 2 needs to wear a mask while on campus, and socially distance 6' from other households as well.

The only bathroom available will be the one off the side hallway, and we ask there to only be one person in line at a time. Be sure you wear your mask even in the bathroom as this is a higher risk environment.

You will notice some things haven't changed since you were last here – there is still no holy water, there is still no sign of peace, no holding hands during the Our Father, and no Precious Blood.

Some additional changes have been added. There will be no congregational singing since this is a prime way to project droplets great distances. A choir practice in Mount Vernon was one of the first super-spreader events in the nation as almost everyone present got the virus. As we begin the Year of the Eucharist, we will also join Catholics throughout the world by kneeling now after the Lamb of God, until the Communion distribution, or at least for right now – until the priest himself sits. This is because communion will be distributed after Mass. Please follow the guidance of our Hospitality Ministers as you come up the side aisles by household. Everyone is asked to receive Holy Communion in the hand. If you need a low gluten host, please come to me only. If you are wearing gloves, you will have to take them off. Be sure to remove your mask before you approach the minister. Return to your pew and once everyone has received they will dismiss everyone in an orderly fashion by pew after I process out. A collection basket is by the side door. You can also mail in your donations, or give online. Thank you for your continued support of our ministry.

Mass will continue to be livestreamed, normally just the 8:30AM and 10:30AM, but this weekend we will livestream the 5PM too, on Vimeo.

We are taking great precautions. But when you attend Mass, you still do so at your own risk. Vulnerable and at-risk persons are still encouraged by the CDC to stay home. And everyone must pass a symptom prescreening questionnaire before signing up or entering the church.

Yes, some changes and sacrifices and inconveniences. But it is important that we do everything we can to provide a safe environment, and we thank you for your help in doing so. Besides, we get to be together for Mass, which is the most important thing of all!!!



# The Holy Sacrifice of the Mass

*With* a general dispensation from the Sunday Mass obligation from Archbishop Etienne still in place, it remains important to keep holy the Lord's Day as much as possible. We realize that not everyone is comfortable returning to Mass at this time given their own health or that of a loved one, and given the maximum capacity constraints, not everyone will be able to attend. Online or TV Mass do not fulfill the Sunday obligation, but it is a good way to remain connected to the central mystery of our faith and Church community. While participating in Mass from home, you are invited to make a Spiritual Communion, which you can find below.



Volunteers, like visitors themselves, need to be healthy, under 60 and have no preexisting medical conditions.



Are you a baptized Catholic in the 7th-12th grade and have not yet been confirmed? Then the Holy Rosary Youth Confirmation Program invites you to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation in the year **2020 - 2021**.

#### Schedule & Format

We are still planning to begin in the Fall of 2020 and conclude in Winter of 2021 with the Mass of Confirmation, whether the program is online, in-person, or a hybrid of both. We are still working on an official schedule and format for the program, and will inform the parish community and those registered for the Confirmation Program as soon as possible.

#### Registration


