# Confession Schedule

For the time being, our grouping is offering Confessions twice per week on Saturdays:

12pm-12:30pm in the parking lot of St. Columbkille

2pm-2:45pm in the parking lot of Our Lady of Lourdes

These will be drive up confessions. Individuals making their confession should do so from



their car. The priest will be outside the car. Please wear a mask if you have one, and be six feet from the priest. Just as privacy is respected in a regular confessional by having only the priest and the individual present, so also with these drive up confessions, it is hoped that, at the time of confession, the only individual in the car would be the one making their confession.

#### When We Gather

Please observe these guidelines as we return to gather in our church spaces for Mass:

- Bring and wear your own mask at all times.
- Practice social distancing by staying 6 feet apart.
- Distribution of the Precious Blood during the Eucharist is suspended.
- Exchange of the sign of peace through physical contact (typically a handshake) is suspended.
- Baskets will not be passed, but will be located in the churches for your envelopes or donations.
- Enter and exit from the designated doors
- Hymnals and missals will not be available.
- Liturgical ministers will be limited; choirs will not be signing.
- Capacity for events will be limited as we proceed.
- Please adhere to directions and respect signage put in place at each building.

Please keep in mind the Sunday obligation for Holy Mass remains lifted and Mass continues to be livestreamed.

The pastoral staff, along with the many volunteers have worked diligently to put all safety protocols into practice. We thank you for your patience and understanding as we return to our churches.
