

The Advent Wreath

Advent wreaths are traditionally constructed of a circle of evergreen branches into which four candles are inserted, representing the four weeks of Advent.

Three candles are purple and one is rose, but white candles may also be used. The purple candles represent the prayer, penance, and charitable works undertaken during this season.

The rose candle is lit on the Third Sunday of Advent (Gaudete Sunday). Gaudete Sunday means “rejoice” and marks the halfway point until Christ’s birth at Christmas.

The subsequent lighting of the candles symbolize the expectation and hope of our Lord’s coming into the world at Christmas, as well as the anticipation of his second coming at the end of time.—USCCB


