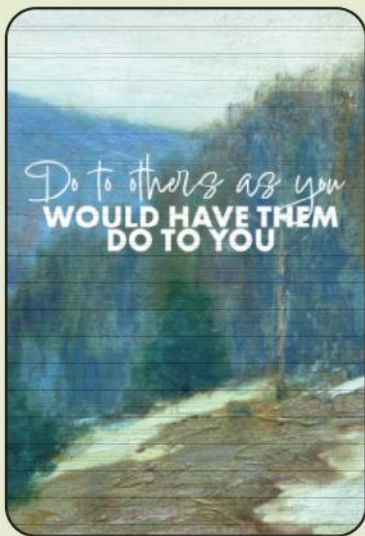

## NEW CLASS OFFERING

God desires you more than you can imagine. However, unless you engage in a genuine life of prayer, you will never truly encounter Him. As stated in the Catechism of the Catholic Church, “*prayer is the encounter of God’s thirst with ours*” (n. 2560).

Father John Ferguson will lead the class which includes videos which are hosted by evangelist Matthew Leonard. The course, “*Introduction to Real Prayer*,” introduces participants to the fundamentals of prayer, its importance, and how to incorporate it into daily life. But it offers much more than just the basics. Matthew guides viewers through the various forms of prayer—vocal, meditative, and contemplative—explaining not only what they are but also how to practice them effectively.

Additionally, he covers the three stages of the spiritual life, which many Catholics may not be familiar with, along with practical steps to make real progress in your spiritual journey. Matthew’s easy-going, conversational style makes these concepts accessible to everyone.

It’s time to get serious about prayer and witness how it can radically transform lives. The course will begin on **Tuesday, March 11, from 7:00pm to 8:15pm** and will conclude on **Tuesday, April 15**, at St. Columbkille Church Hall. Join us this Lenten season to deepen your intimacy with the Lord through prayer! 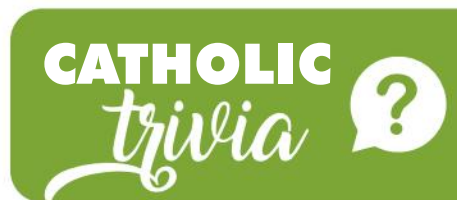

What do Lent and quarantine have in common? They share a common origin. In ancient times, the Church required individuals who committed certain sins to undergo public penance starting on Ash Wednesday, which included restrictions such as not bathing or talking to others. This penance lasted for 40 days, hence the term “quarantine,” derived from the Latin word for “forty.” In the 14<sup>th</sup> century, during the bubonic plague, ships arriving from infected areas had to anchor for forty days at sea before entering port. This established the modern concept of quarantine as a form of isolation due to illness.

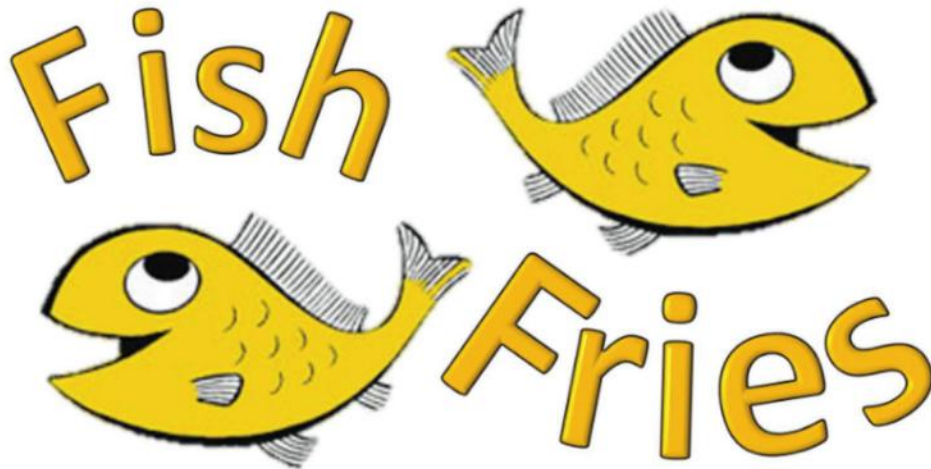

## VOLUNTEER INCOME TAX ASSISTANCE

The IRS's Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) and Tax Counseling for the Elderly (TCE) programs offer free basic tax return preparation to qualified individuals. VITA sites offer free tax help to people who need assistance in preparing their own tax returns, including: (1) People who generally make \$60,000 or less, (2) Persons with disabilities; and (3) Limited English-speaking taxpayers. In addition to VITA, the TCE program offers free tax help, particularly for those who are 60 years of age and older, specializing in questions about pensions and retirement-related issues unique to seniors.

There are several VITA/TCE sites in our area including: Moon Township Library – Moon Twp., PA; The Bible Chapel – McMurray, PA; Fort Steuben Mall – Steubenville, OH.
