- 2. be a Catholic who has been confirmed and has already received the Sacrament of the Most Holy Eucharist and leads a life in harmony with the faith and the role to be undertaken.
- 3. receive the sacraments on a regular basis
- 4. not be bound by any Canonical penalty
- 5. if married, be validly married according to the norms of the church
- 6. not be the child's mother or father
- 7. obtain a letter from his/her pastor attesting to his/her eligibility to serve as a sponsor.


