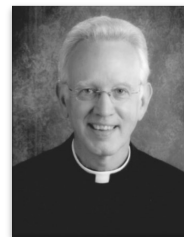


**The 51st Annual Holiday Fair

1st Quarter Highlights

Given that the Vikings have a bye weekend, you may have more time to review the highlights from the first quarter of our financial year (July-September). Perhaps Packer fans can find the time and energy to do likewise? The Finance Councils at both HF and SJW met this week and I want to provide you with a summary of our finances thus far.



SJW: As of September 30th, church support totaled \$81,267.03 toward the budgeted amount of \$84,113.50, which results in a shortfall of \$2,846.47. On a positive note, the month of September exceeded the budget by \$548.57. Unrestricted expenses totaled \$178,223.84 compared to the budgeted amount of \$158,310.10; some unbudgeted expenses included the widening of the driveway and expanding the parking lot (\$9,950) and the feasibility study (\$6,000). When we look at the overall picture, the deficit for the first quarter is approximately \$11,000. I am hoping that the second quarter, which includes year-end and Christmas giving, will help us make up lost ground and I encourage you to check and make sure that your giving is up-to-date.

HF: At the end of September, church support totaled \$25,638.41 toward the budgeted amount of \$25,406, which is \$232.41 over budget. Unfortunately, the month of September fell short of budget by \$1,608.84. Unrestricted expenses totaled \$62,445.20 compared to the budgeted amount of \$34,982.02; most of this expense (\$29,941.44) relates to the capital improvements for the new entrance. When we look at the overall picture, the deficit for the first quarter is approximately \$5,500. If we can continue to give more than the budgeted amount, especially in the second quarter, I am confident that we can make up for the shortfall by the end of the year. After the final numbers for the construction are agreed upon, I will send a letter to all parishioners with a summary of the costs, an appeal to make up for unforeseen expenses and a listing of improvements we would still like to accomplish (e.g. improved lighting in the church and sanctuary, some decorative enhancements and replacement of the church hall carpet).

A gentle invitation/reminder to those who give electronically: If you haven't reviewed your monthly payment for a while, please do so and see if you are now in a financial position to give more. Thanks to all for your active involvement and support of our parishes! I think that we have many reasons to be grateful as Thanksgiving approaches, especially our parish life, ministries and facilities.

- The Automatic Payment Plan saves both you and the parish time and money because you write fewer checks and you have the peace of mind knowing your payment was made on time. Your monthly bank statement (or your on-line balance) will show proof of your payment.
