

Summer Challenge

While I was growing up, my father served as the Financial Secretary for the Knights of Columbus Council in my home parish, St. Mary's Church in Worthington. In addition to keeping the records, he also addressed the newsletter and mailed it to all the members. The addressing machine was at the rectory and sometimes I would help him with this task. Perhaps I should mention that my childhood pastor usually



had (large) Hershey candy bars that he might share with helpful children like me. ;-) The K.C. Council was very service oriented, both in the parish (festivals, breakfasts, etc.) and in the community (bringing children with disabilities to church, etc.). It was only natural for me to join the Knights during my college years and I have been a member, both active and inactive, since then. One resource provided to K.C. members is their publication, *Columbia* magazine, and now they also offer many resources online. When I returned from vacation, I found an email from the Knights in my inbox with a July challenge from the Supreme Chaplain. It might be a challenge all of us can consider:

"The apostles gathered together with Jesus and reported all they had done and taught. He said to them, 'Come away by yourselves to a deserted place and rest a while'" (Mk 6:30, from the Gospel for July 22).

If we are honest, we know that we are not that good at "coming away ... to a deserted place" to "rest for a while." In fact, over 80 percent of us check our smart phones even before brushing our teeth in the morning and spend time on them in the last hour before we go to sleep. Like the apostles, we focus on getting a lot done. But let's imagine what would happen if we truly responded to the challenge of uses to "come away" to pray in solitude every morning, resting in His presence and holy Word. Jesus invites us to put first things first. Let's take him at his word and make the changes we need to make.

5000YOUR GOAL FOR JULY: This month, I challenge you to "come away" to a quiet place by praying at least five minutes a day, first thing in the morning before you check your electronic devices or turn on the TV. You will likely have stops and starts, but strive to be as consistent as possible. In addition, I challenge you to respond to Jesus' invitation to "rest a while" by doing something truly restful on Sunday, the day of rest.

No, it's not a chocolate candy bar, but this challenge will bring even greater rewards!
