The death of President Bush and the many remembrances by his family, friends and colleagues brought to mind the meaning of "benefactor" - one who does good things; it was touching to learn how many lives he touched through deeds of simple thoughtfulness, like a thank you note. As 2018 comes to a close, I through giving of their time, spiritual support, "sweat equity" or financial resources. Some benefactors surprise us with a gift in their estate planning. - "Avoid envy, lust, hatred and negative feelings ..."
- Are my thoughts and actions destructive toward my relationships?
- "Reach out to those who need you ... this is how you will be judged."
- Do I assist the weak, the elderly, the sick?
- "Let go of ..."
- "The bitterness that brings us to revenge"

Let's use these Advent days for a little spiritual "house cleaning" to make more room for the coming of Immanuel, "God-with-us"!
