

# **Need a Late Lenten Prayer?**

As we enter into the last days of Lent, we might benefit from an encouraging prayer to help us prepare well for the Triduum, the Sacred Three Days, that is the highpoint of the liturgical year. Last week we had the annual collection for Catholic Relief Services (CRS), which supports vulnerable people around the world and here in the United States. CRS recently provided the following prayer that seems timely for these late Lenten days:



#### With Joyful and Generous Hearts

God of all comfort, all our delight is in you. As a deer yearns for streams of water so our hearts long for you. Your blessing restores us. Your love sustains us. Your word guides us. Even as we fast, you fill us. Even as we pray, you answer. Even as we cry, you comfort. When we seek, we find. When we knock, you open. When we ask, you bless. Lord, help us to give as you give, with open hands and hearts. Teach us to live as you live, with joyful and generous hearts. Amen

If you forgot your envelope for this collection, it's not too late to bring it next week or mail it to the office; as with other collections, you can also contribute online through our website. CRS also sponsors the Rice Bowl, which is one of my favorite ways to support their mission here and abroad. You can return your Rice Bowl on Holy Thursday evening or whenever it is convenient for you, preferably by Easter or soon after.

Looking ahead, here are a few possibilities to enrich the last days of Lent 2023:

- + This <u>Wednesday, March 29<sup>th</sup></u>, our Faith Formation students will be leading the Stations of the Cross at both Holy Family & St. Joseph the Worker Churches at <u>6:40 pm</u>. (This is in addition to our Friday evening Stations at 5:15 pm.)
- + <u>Sunday, April 2<sup>nd</sup></u>, is our joint (SJB & SJWHF) Lenten Communal Reconciliation at St. John the Baptist Church at <u>1:00 pm</u>.
- + Our <u>Diocesan Chrism Mass</u> will be held at <u>St. Augustine Church in Austin</u> on <u>Monday, April 3<sup>rd</sup>, at 4:00 pm</u>; Bishop Barron will preside and preach, and most of the priests and deacons of the Diocese will be participating.

#### Veil of Veronica

We long to see God. But, as the apostle Paul said, "At present we see indistinctly." However, the time will come when we see him face-to-face.

That time has begun with Jesus, who is the face of God! Over the centuries of Christian life, friends of Jesus have drawn closer to God by meditating on the gift of the Incarnation: God become human. They have done this through devotion to the holy face of Jesus. For example, you might have heard of St. Therese of Lisieux. Her full religious name was St. Therese of the Child Jesus and the Holy Face.

When people focus their prayer on the holy face of Jesus, it is the face of the suffering Jesus. The roots of this image go back to traditions that developed in later centuries about a woman who met Jesus, either during his ministry or on his way to Calvary. Jesus' face was imprinted on a cloth that she carried, a "true image," or **vera icona** in Latin. Thus the woman came to be known as Veronica.

We do not know the historical facts behind any of these traditions, but we do know that Jesus was the Word made flesh. In his voice, his hands, and his face we find compassion, love, and the true presence of our loving God.

#### The Sixth Station of the Cross:

From the crowd comes a woman. She can no longer stand by and watch Jesus suffer. She must do something. Veronica does not change the outcome of the day, but her small action does make a big difference. Her compassion and courage are signs of her love for Jesus. May we also have compassion, courage, and show our love for Jesus Christ.


