Behavior for the Whole Event:

1. Participant will be on time for all check-ins and departure times.
2. Participants will immediately obey the directions of all chaperones.
3. Participants are NEVER to be alone. Participants will always have a “buddy” or group of “buddies” with them.
4. Participants are NEVER to be in a private place with a member of the opposite sex (adult or minor).
5. Participants and Chaperones will notify Beverly Miller immediately if there is a problem or concern.
6. Participants will respect all property and individuals. (Vandalism, damage due to carelessness and physical harassment are not tolerated)
7. Participants will not leave the event without notifying Beverly Miller directly. Parents must verify permission for their youth to leave before 7:30 PM. Parents will notify Beverly if their youth will arrive after 4:00 PM.
8. Not have in possession any tobacco, vaping, alcohol, marijuana or any controlled illegal substance.
9. I agree that if any of these terms are violated, the St. Joseph the Worker/Holy Family Youth Coordinator can send the participant home at the participant/guardian’s expense.
