To begin the process of having your child baptized, please call the office or visit our website.


FUNERALS

While there are countless ways to give back and do good to support your community, here are a few ideas to inspire you during Lent. **Reflection:** As you share your time and talent ask yourself: Why is it important to make time for service or helping others in my busy life?

Operation Pillowcase: Sew and/or Decorate.

But part of the power of Lent is that we focus as a community on renewing our faith and preparing for Easter. Our Lenten practices have a purpose and a goal. Therein lies the secret. When we focus our efforts on one virtue, or try to change one bad habit, or seek to deepen our understanding of one aspect of faith, we focus our efforts and give our full attention to what we are trying to accomplish. We tend to be more successful achieving our goals. More importantly, it has a ripple effect in our lives: one thing changes or is added to the spiritual mix of our lives and many aspects are changed.

ST. BERNADETTE EARLY CHILDHOOD CONNECTIONS REGISTRATION INFORMATION 2023-2024

ECC strives to meet the needs of the children of our diverse community. We welcome all children. Our positive Christian learning environment recognizes the uniqueness of each child as we work with parents to prepare their child for success. In selecting the number of days of attendance for your child, a parent should consider his/her child's interest, readiness, social skills, and emotional development. Final placement of each child will be determined by direct observation of the child in the classroom by the teacher and director.

St. Bernadette Early Childhood Connections strives to place each child in the best learning environment. Our teaching staff is highly qualified and teacher requests are not accepted. No child will be considered registered until the Registration fee has been paid and all registration forms have been completed. There are NO REFUNDS of registration fee.

In addition to the online registration information, we require **BACK TO SCHOOL** paperwork consisting of a Student Health Record (must be signed by child's physician), an Acknowledgment/ Release/Permission form, Food Allergy Care Plan (if applicable,) and an Automated Tuition Express form. A copy of each child's immunization record is required, as well. These forms will be posted online by the end of June. The forms MUST be printed, completed, and submitted to the ECC Office by August 1. A \$50 late fee will be charged on August 11, for any packet not submitted in a timely manner. NO child will be admitted on the first day of school without these required forms.

Ages 1-year-old to 5 years-old 9:00 a.m. – 1:00 p.m. All classes must have a minimum for the class to be offered.


