To begin the process of having your child baptized, please call the office or visit our website.


FUNERALS

MARRIAGE



Christian Action is here to serve registered parishioners and families in our community. We serve our neighbors in crisis living in the following zip codes: 77062, 77058, 77059, 77598. We assist with utilities, food, and clothing. We have a clothing distribution 4 times a year. Neighbors in need may call on Monday or Wednesday (9:30 - 11:30 am) to

pick up bags of supplemental groceries on Tuesday or Thursday (9:30 - 11:00 am). No walk-ins. Families in need are eligible for food assistance once a month. As of May 1, Christian Action's Food Pantry returned to pre-pandemic eligibility serving families in the zip codes mentioned above.

Christian Action donation drop off hours are Monday - Thursday 9:00 am to 12:00 pm. We **DO NOT** accept expired food items, glass containers, large items or furniture.



Office of Child and Youth Protection USCCB Charter Audit

The Safe Environment compliance and renewal training is a condition of employment and for volunteer ministry in our Archdiocese.

All clergy, employees, contracted school personnel, volunteers, members of groups, movements, and organizations over the age of 18, who work, volunteer or participate in any capacity are required to complete the Archdiocesan Safe Environment Training and a criminal background check before they may begin employment or volunteer activities.

Mandatory renewal training must be completed every five years and a new background check submitted before the five-year expiration of prior training. The training is free and can be done from home.
