angels are shown pleading with Jesus to hold back his wrath against lust, avarice, and pride. Jesus is rearing back to launch arrows upon them, yet Mary begs him to withhold his judgment.

The Book of Wisdom praises God, for "he is master of might, but governs with lenience." The fact is, he would be fully justified to reprimand every vice of his creatures, yet he chooses mercy. What a wonderful lesson for all persons in authority!

Jesús está levantando de nuevo para lanzar flechas sobre ellos, pero María le pide que retenga su juicio. El Libro de la Sabiduría alaba a Dios, porque "él es dueño del poder, pero gobierna con indulgencia". El hecho es que estaría plenamente justificado para reprender cada vicio de sus criaturas, pero escoge misericordia. ¡Qué maravillosa lección para todas las personas en autoridad! Basta con mirar un Evangelio. Las malas hierbas no son inmediatamente arrancadas o quemadas por la consideración del trigo. ## Dear Padre,

## If I'm late for Mass, can I receive the Eucharist?

There is no hard-and-fast rule on how "late" one can be for Mass and **L** still receive Communion. Holy Communion is offered outside of Mass at times, so theoretically you could come during the Communion rite and still receive Communion.

But there is more to be considered with this question. If you are going to go Mass, you should be there from the beginning to the end. You should be there before the entrance procession begins and you should stay until the last verse of the final song is sung. Things happen, like an unexpected train on the way to Mass or a sick child who needs attention and care. However, if you find yourself always coming late to Mass, you may need to make a change in your routine.

I remember cleaning out a closet of a church I was stationed at, and I found a sign with ropes attached to it. It stated, "Mass has begun, the next Mass begins at..." and there was a place where you could list the time of the next Mass. I was told the ropes were tied across the entrance so you couldn't come into Mass late.

Those days are gone, though. It's up to you to follow your conscience. It is important to participate in the entire celebration, but if on the rare occasion

vou come late to Mass, ask yourself, "Can I prepare myself to worthily receive Communion at this moment?" If you can answer "yes" to that question, then I would say it would be OK to receive Communion.


