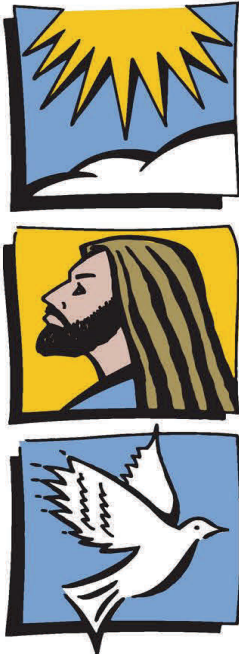

The Holy Trinity: Our Faith Foundation

The Trinity at first appears as the most abstract belief in Christianity. It touches the mystery of God's nature, how he exists, and how he acts. So, yes, it is mysterious. But as with all foundational truths, they have far-reaching effects. It is essential to grasp the basics because, if not, everything you build with them will be faulty. Thus it is vital for Christians to

understand and believe in the Trinity. This is a basic building block of all we believe. "The mystery of the Most Holy Trinity is the central mystery of Christian faith and life" (*Catechism of the Catholic Church*, 234).

The pope and one of the earliest councils of bishops confronted just this question of the Trinity. At the Council of Nicaea in the year 325, the bishops discussed what Jesus revealed to us about the Trinity. The fruit of their meetings nearly 1,700 years ago is the Nicene Creed that we still pray today.

The three divine persons are one and the same in their divine nature, but distinct in their relations. God the Father Almighty is the Creator of heaven and earth. Jesus Christ is the Word through whom the Father created all things and the Savior he sent into the world. The Holy Spirit is the love of the Father and Son who is sent to sanctify humanity by leading people in the truth revealed by the Father and Son. God is the Creator, Jesus the Savior, and the Holy Spirit is Sanctifier and Teacher. Three divine persons acting together with a common mission, but one God. —Fr. Mark Haydu, LC

For Reflection

God exists as three persons in one divine family, so what does that say to me about how I should live in my family?

In God there is unity of essence in a diversity of missions. How does creation reflect his unity and harmony in diversity?

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La Trinidad al principio aparece como la creencia más abstracta en el cristianismo. Toca el misterio de la naturaleza de Dios, cómo existe y cómo actúa. Entonces, sí, es misterioso. Pero como con todas las verdades fundamentales, tienen efectos de gran alcance. Es esencial comprender lo básico porque, de lo contrario, todo lo que construyas con ellos será defectuoso. Por lo tanto, es vital para los cristianos entender y creer en la Trinidad. Este es un componente básico de todo lo que creemos. "El misterio de la Santísima Trinidad es el misterio central de la fe y la vida cristiana" (*Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica*, 234). El Papa y uno de los primeros concilios de obispos se enfrentaron a esta pregunta de la Trinidad. En el Concilio de Nicea en el año 325, los obispos discutieron lo que Jesús nos reveló acerca de la Trinidad. El fruto de sus reuniones hace casi 1,700 años es el Credo de Nicea que aún oramos hoy. Las tres personas divinas son una y la misma en su naturaleza divina, pero distintas en sus relaciones. Dios el Padre Todopoderoso es el Creador del cielo y de la tierra. Jesucristo es la Palabra a través de la cual el Padre creó todas las cosas y el Salvador que envió al mundo. El Espíritu Santo es el amor del Padre y el Hijo que es enviado a santificar a la humanidad guiando a las personas en la verdad revelada por el Padre y el Hijo. Dios es el Creador, Jesús el Salvador, y el Espíritu Santo es Santificador y Maestro. Tres personas divinas actuando juntas con una misión común, pero un solo Dios.

Dear Padre,

Is there a simple way of understanding how I am to be a Catholic father?

I wish you and all fathers a Father's Day filled with God's protection of you and your family. May God surround you all with a circle of love!

The simplest way to understand fatherhood is to pray the Lord's Prayer, the Our Father. This prayer was originally spoken in Aramaic, a language related to Hebrew. Aramaic was probably Jesus' native tongue. The word Jesus used for "father" was an Aramaic word: *abba*, which means "papa" or "dad." When we say the Our Father, we speak to God in a very intimate way; we pray to God not as a distant figure but as a close and comfortable member of the family. It is this rather shocking intimacy that Jesus wants to get across to his disciples when he teaches them to pray.

As you relate to God in a very intimate way, you should relate in the same manner to your spouse and family. Intimacy means closeness, involvement, love, and understanding. As a father, you must be physically present in the home. But more than just a physical presence is necessary. You must also seek an emotional closeness with your spouse and children. You must show a constant interest in their lives. Encourage them by doing things with them. You must strive constantly to reject anger, rage, or an unforgiving attitude, and instead embrace gentleness, encouragement, and understanding. God the Father does all of these things for us.
