Sonship Restored

Strangely enough and discouragingly often, we find the attitude of the older son from the Prodigal Son parable in the Church. The righteous believers who have always belonged can be jealous and look down upon the poor sinner who comes later and gets the same reward.

Yet, the attitude of all of us toward those who are spiritually, morally, or materially needy should be that of the loving father so wonderfully shown in the statue by Francesco Messina.

The sinner comes back in shame, weakness, and obvious failure. His very act of returning is a cry for help, support, and understanding. The father offers his mercy and compassion without questions, without an interrogation. His shoulder is never too proud, too hard, or righteous to be refused as a pillow for the humiliated soul who returns broken, pillaged, and ruined by sin.

Messina chose to show the father and son naked because it symbolizes mankind stripped to its essence. And in this you reveal greatness. Humanity is noblest when admitting its weakness. Humanity is greatest in its ability to show mercy and lift the downtrodden. The father-son relationship is most beautiful when it is being reconciled and restored.

We should always rejoice at the return of a prodigal child, and we should always honor a forgiving parental heart. "We must celebrate and rejoice," said the father. If we are convinced of this, we now have a charge: Go out and find the lost coin and welcome back the lost sheep with humility and joy!

Los creyentes justos que siempre han pertenecido pueden estar celosos y despreciar al pobre pecador que viene más tarde y recibe la misma recompensa. Sin embargo, la actitud de todos nosotros hacia aquellos que son espiritualmente, moral o materialmente necesitados debería ser del padre amoroso que tan maravillosamente muestra Francesco Messina en la estatua. El pecador regresa con vergüenza, debilidad y evidente fracasado. Su mismo acto de regreso es un grito de ayuda, apoyo y comprensión. El padre ofrece su misericordia y compasión sin preguntas, sin un interrogatorio. Su hombro nunca es demasiado orgulloso, demasiado duro o justo para ser rechazado como una almohada para el alma humillada que regresa rota, saqueada y arruinada por el pecado. Messina eligió mostrar al padre y al hijo desnudos porque simboliza a la humanidad despojada de su esencia. Y en esto revelas grandeza. La humanidad es más noble cuando admite su debilidad. La humanidad es más grande en su habilidad para mostrar misericordia y levantar a los oprimidos. La relación padre-hijo es más bella cuando se reconcilia y restaura. Siempre debemos alegrarnos por el regreso de un niño pródigo, y siempre debemos honrar a un corazón paternal que perdona. "Debemos celebrar y alegrarnos", dijo el padre. Si estamos convencidos de esto, ahora tenemos un cargo: ¡sal y encuentra la moneda perdida y da la bienvenida a las ovejas perdidas con humildad y alegría!

BLESSED BE GOD IN ALL THE SAINTS: SAINT PROFILE OF THE MONTH



ST. ANDREW KIM TAEAGON

Feast Day: September 20th

Canonized: May 6, 1984

The first native Korean priest, Andrew Kim Taegon was the son of Christian converts. Born on August 21 1821, Andrew came from a family of martyrs. During the 19th century, Catholics in Korea were persecuted by the ruling Joseon Dynasty for abandoning Confucianism and Andrew's great-grandfather, Kim Chin-hu Pius, died in prison in 1814 after being arrested for his conversion to Catholicism. Following his baptism at the age of 15, Andrew traveled 1,300 miles to the seminary in Macao, China. After six years, he managed to return to his country through Manchuria. That same year he crossed the Yellow Sea to Shanghai and was ordained a priest. He then returned to Korea and catechised local communities by night.

Andrew was arrested in June 1846 after a failed attempt to smuggle French missionaries into Korea. Initially, the king resisted executing Andrew on account of his bright personality and broad learning. Eventually, however, he was sentenced to death and was beheaded on September 16 1846 on the banks of the Han River near Seoul, after prolonged torture. His last words were: "I have held communication with foreigners, it has been for my religion and for my God. It is for Him that I die. My immortal life is on the point of beginning. Become Christians if you wish to be happy after death, because God has eternal chastisements in store for those who have refused to know Him."

St. Andrew is venerated as the patron saint of Korean clergy. In August this year, Pope Francis visited the birthplace of St. Andrew in Solmoe during his four-day trip to South Korea.
