LAETARE SUNDAY

A Time for Joy



The name “Laetare” comes from the Latin, meaning “**Rejoice.**”

That’s what we are called to do on the Fourth Sunday of Lent, which comes about halfway through the Lenten Season. Marked by the use of rose-colored vestments, it is a time for us to express hope and joy in anticipation of Easter and Christ’s resurrection.

The custom of celebrating Laetare Sunday likely began in the early Church as a celebration of catechumens who were preparing to be baptized at Easter. Today, catechumens undergo the second of three scrutinies—liturgical rites of repentance and preparation.

Saint Benedict emphasized that Lenten observances, while being practical, should also be inspiring, making an offering to God with the “joy of the Holy Spirit.” He stressed the importance of waiting for Easter “in the joy of holy desire,” highlighting the value of hope and anticipation during Lent.

So, let’s rejoice this Laetare Sunday. Easter—and the resurrection of Jesus Christ—will be here soon.

FATHER JIM'S WEEKLY REFLECTIONS

Fourth Sunday of Lent

This weekend we celebrate what the Church refers to as **Laetare Sunday**. Laetare is Latin for "rejoice." If we have been faithful to our Lenten disciplines then we are beginning to see how the divine grace of our Lord is leading us into a deeper conversion to Jesus as we prepare for Easter. So, "rejoice" that the mercy of God is helping us to be the saints that He calls us to be.

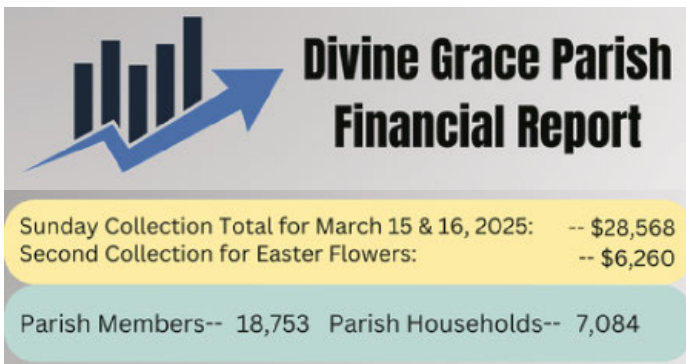

Divine Grace parishioners are invited to an important meeting to discuss the upcoming **renovation of Oldenski Hall** at Saint Ferdinand. The gathering will be held this **Mon., March 31** at 7:00 pm in Saint Ferdinand Church.

About \$2.7 million from the *Church Alive* campaign is available for the project, which is expected to begin in 2027.

Parish leaders will describe how the hall is currently used, then parishioners will have an opportunity to offer their ideas for potential future uses.

Named for **Father Kenneth Oldenski**, the third pastor of Saint Ferdinand, the hall served as the parish's first church building from 1965 until the current church opened in 1990.



This is a wonderful opportunity for prayer, reflection, and community fellowship. Everyone is welcome to participate in this spiritual journey.

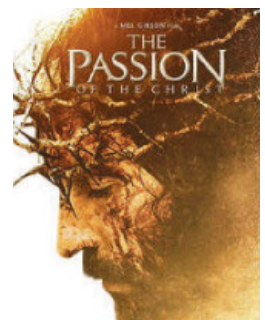

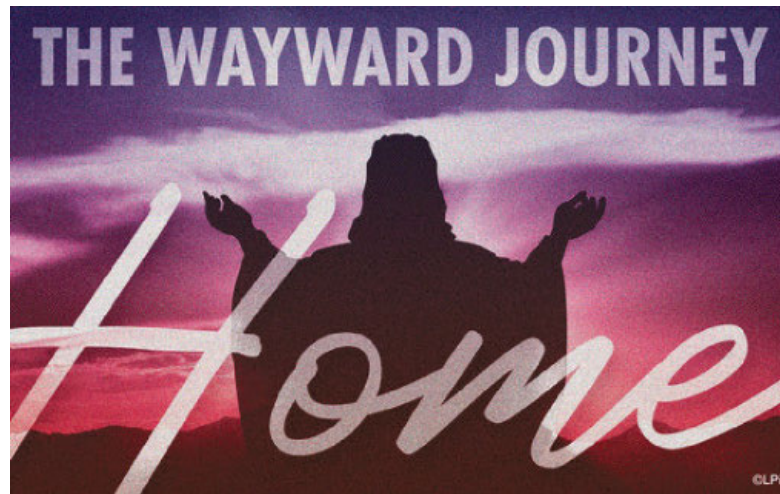

Unpacking the Word

Joshua 5:9a, 10-12

After the Exodus, Israel wandered in the desert of the Sinai peninsula for forty years. Moses handed over leadership and his personal authority to Joshua before his death (see Numbers 27:12-23 and Joshua 1:1-5). In an event strikingly similar to the crossing of the Red Sea forty years earlier, Joshua led the people through the parted waters of the Jordan River and into the Promised Land near Gilgal (see Joshua 3:14-17). He did not immediately lead the charge toward Jericho though. Instead, the people settled down to celebrate the Passover.

The last recorded Passover celebration was 39 years earlier at the foot of Mt. Sinai (see Numbers 9:1-5). It seems that Israel celebrated the Passover annually for two years and then possibly forgot about it during all their murmuring in the desert. After this first Passover in the Promised Land, the Lord's miraculous gift of manna stopped. For forty years, they had eaten this food for breakfast, lunch, and dinner every day without fail. But once they were able to eat the produce of the land, there was no need for it anymore.

The events recorded in this reading point ahead to Jesus in very clear ways. Joshua and Jesus are the same name in Hebrew, and so one day a New Joshua would lead God's People on a New Exodus out of slavery to sin. He would institute a New Passover by giving us a New Manna in the Eucharist. He would lead us in battle against a different sort of Jericho so that we could ultimately settle in a New Promised Land in Heaven. History doesn't repeat itself, but it often rhymes, and the Lord is the same yesterday, today, and forever.





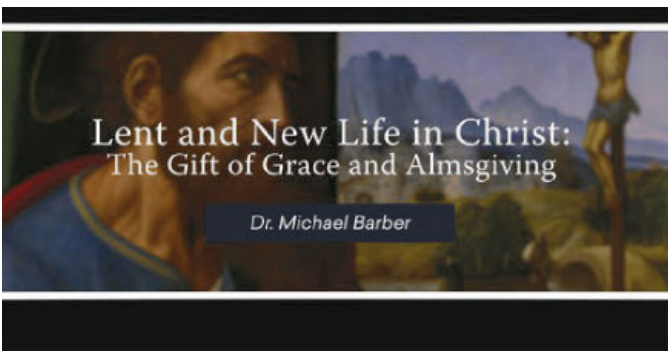

THE GOSPEL OF MARK
