Calling on the Holy Spirit

Two eighth graders who are among more than 100 candidates receiving the Sacrament of Confirmation at Divine Grace Parish say they're looking forward to growing in the faith.

"My sponsor has been helping me to understand the gifts of the Holy Spirit," said **Christian Meyer**, who is about to graduate from Saint Gregory School. "Being confirmed means growing closer to the Lord through prayer and service. The Holy Spirit is always there to help me."

Bishop David Zubik will confirm 112 candidates, including five adults, on **Saturday, May 31**, at 10:00 am and 1:00 pm at Saint Ferdinand Church.

Confirmation is vital for both candidates and the Church. As a sacrament of initiation, it helps Catholics to be disciples committed to spreading the Gospel. It is a rite of passage that signifies a more mature and intentional desire to live out one's faith in the world.

Matthew Burr, who is a member of the LifeTeen youth group, attended weekly preparation classes, studying the lives of the saints and learning the Seven Gifts of the Holy Spirit—wisdom, understanding, counsel, fortitude, knowledge, piety, and fear of the Lord.

"The Sacrament of Confirmation is a way to deepen my faith and ask the Holy Spirit to guide me through the hard times and the good times," Matthew said.



The 7 Gifts of the Holy Spirit

- 1. WISDOM:** helps us see the world differently and from God's point of view.
- 2. UNDERSTANDING:** enables us to know more clearly the mysteries of faith.
- 3. COUNSEL** [also known as **Right Judgment**]: helps us to discern what is right and what is wrong.
- 4. FORTITUDE** [also known as **Courage**]: strengthens our will so that we can actually accomplish what is true, good and beautiful.
- 5. KNOWLEDGE:** enables us to discover God's will in all things.
- 6. PIETY:** helps us to love God, our merciful Father, and to obey his precepts out of love for him.
- 7. FEAR OF THE LORD** [also known as **Wonder and Awe**]: helps us to understand how we must depend on God for everything. In other words, he is God, we are not.

Helping K of C Help Others

Thanks to your generous support, the **Knights of Columbus** Council 11838 at Saint Ferdinand distributed \$21,295 in the past fiscal year. Of this, \$8,824 was returned to parish ministries. We gave \$3,000 to our seminarians and \$2,000 to Dry Bones Ministries. Acts 15:28-29

Unpacking the Word

Acts 15:1-2, 22-29

What can we do when devoted and well-intended followers of Jesus disagree on what Jesus taught or how it applies to a current situation or need? Our first reading today shows us that the Apostles and the Early Church handled these situations by a gathering of bishops to discuss the matter and reach an authoritative decision sanctioned by Peter. This is the precursor to all local synods and councils and to all 21 ecumenical councils, Vatican II in the 1960's being the latest.

The lectionary presents us with the problem and the final solution but skips over Acts 15:3-21 where the solution is reached. In these intervening verses, Peter clarifies the basic principle at work that God himself has already visibly given the Holy Spirit to the gentiles without circumcision and so the Church cannot insist on circumcision anymore. Then Paul and Barnabas describe their experience of preaching to non-Jews before James suggests a way to express their decision. They crafted a statement, the first magisterial document of the Church, and sent it out to the entire Church, which at this time only extended into modern Turkey.

This is still the practice of the Lord's Church today. Bishops gather in synod to discuss a current issue, and the Pope writes a statement, called a post-synodal apostolic exhortation, to present the decision to the world. We have seen Pope Francis lead this process for twelve years, and now we will witness this very same process from our first reading play out in the ministry of Pope Leo XIV.

In addition to the actual decision about circumcision, the key phrase in this document is “It is the decision of the Holy Spirit and of us...” When the Church makes a definitive statement on issues of faith and morals, it is not merely the decision of some old men in Rome. It is the decision of the Holy Spirit. Jesus promised that the Holy Spirit would guide his Church's leaders, and those first leaders clearly understood that this was the case. The same dynamic is still in play today as it has been for 2,000 years. How can we know what God says, what he actually means, and how it applies to us today? We can listen to the decisions of the Holy Spirit through the decisions of his Church.
