

Longtime Volunteers are Happy Helpers

Staging a parish festival for upwards of 20,000 visitors takes a lot of planning and people. But why do many volunteer year after year?

Vera Belfiore and **Joan Rycheck** say they receive as much if not more than they contribute, and are blessed to help out with the White Elephant Sale.

Vera is in charge of "VMOS" items, which stands for "Video, Music, Office and School." Three days a week she and her team of volunteers sort hundreds of donated items, preparing them for sale during the festival, set for **August 8-10**. She's also busy in other volunteer roles at Saint Ferdinand—as sacristan, helping priests prepare for Mass, serving as an

Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion, and leading an adult Bible study.

Joan has volunteered for several years with her daughter Juley. They sort through donated jewelry and purses, preparing for the sale. "I enjoy working with my daughter," Joan says. "And I love to see the faces of so many people light up when they know what wonderful buys they are getting. The sale benefits both the community and the parish, which makes our efforts so worthwhile."

Vera has been a festival volunteer for nearly 20 years, and loves being at Divine Grace Parish. "Faith encourages us to do good works. I pray, 'Lord, keep me going in your House.' I just want to serve Him."

Joan points to the lasting friendships she's gained working at the White Elephant Sale. "Volunteering helps you to grow, it's fun, and you're doing God's work," she says. To anyone thinking of volunteering at the festival or other parish activities, Vera is encouraging. "Go ahead and do it. You will be so grateful."







Unpacking the Word

— Genesis 18:1-10a —

In our first reading from Genesis, Abraham experiences a theophany, an appearance of the divine. The Lord manifested himself as three men. This is often depicted in sacred art as three angels. The one God showing himself as three men is a fairly obvious wink toward the fuller Christian understanding of God as a Trinity, three distinct and divine Persons united as only one God.

In addition to its trinitarian overtones, this passage is especially revealing when read with this week's Gospel account of Mary sitting at Jesus' feet. Both episodes present a faithful follower resting with the Lord, relaxing together and enjoying refreshment and conversation. It's an image of Christian prayer, which is far more than mindless recitation of words. Prayer with the Lord is a personal encounter, a relationship lived out, an intimate conversation. It ought to involve rest, relaxation, and two-way conversation.

St. Therese of Lisieux described prayer in this way: "For me, prayer is a surge of the heart; is it a simple look turned toward heaven, it is a cry of recognition and of love, embracing for trial and joy" (quoted in CCC 2558). This is also an apt description of Abraham's discussion with the Lord. Though it doesn't appear that Abraham mentioned his lack of a child, the narrative leading up to this event describes in great detail the angst in his heart over having no son by which God could fulfill His promise of numerous descendants. This concern was foremost in Abraham's mind and heart, and it is exactly what the Lord speaks to during this restful encounter in his tent during the heat of the day.

What does resting and conversing with the Lord look like for you? Do you let Him into your tent in the heat of the day or leave Him in His church where you visit when you want to?




