Dedication of St. John Lateran Basilica

This weekend, the Universal Church celebrates the dedication of St. John Lateran Basilica in Rome which serves as the Cathedral for the Bishop of Rome, the Pope. Saint Peter Basilica serves as the seat for the Pope as Universal Pastor of the Church while he is also the Bishop of Rome. The Lateran Family donated this property in the 4th century for the Pope to build a cathedral. The very table that Jesus sat at during the Last Supper and Saint Peter used to celebrate Mass is here. Pope Francis chose this basilica in which to be buried. This weekend's feast is a reminder of the sacredness of Catholic churches in which Mass and the sacraments of the Church are celebrated daily. We are privileged to have three churches that comprise our parish.

Getting Ready for Advent

We are hosting a three-day Pre-Advent Parish Mission at Saint Ferdinand Church from **November 17-19** featuring Nick De La Torre, host of *The Awaken Catholic Show*. Monday and Tuesday evening begin at 7:00 pm and include Nick's presentations on the healing power of prayer, the importance of Adoration and Confession, and getting ourselves ready for Advent. The Mission ends on Wednesday with an evening of Healing & Liberation presented by Dry Bones Ministries. Hope to see you there!

New Features of Saint Gregory Organ

The Saint Gregory Organ Restoration is nearly complete! The new organ is a hybrid instrument, meaning it is a combination of pipe organ and digital technology. The foundation of the instrument is the original 32 rank Schantz pipe organ which has been carefully removed, restored, and reinstalled by the Luley Organ Company. Luley's restoration includes a newly created 8' Trompette en Chamade, whose pipework is installed above the crucifix, and newly crafted facades on both sides of the altar and above the crucifix. Gerrero-Kirk Classical Organ, Inc. crafted the new 4 manual console, the

moveable platform it sits upon, and 71 digital ranks created to enhance the restored pipework. If you would like to donate to this historic project, please do so by indicating the donation on your check. I will send you a letter of confirmation.

Mark your calendars for the Dedication Concert of the new organ. It will take place on **Friday, January 30** at 7:00 pm and is open to all. Those who contributed to the restoration will receive a special invitation from me in December.

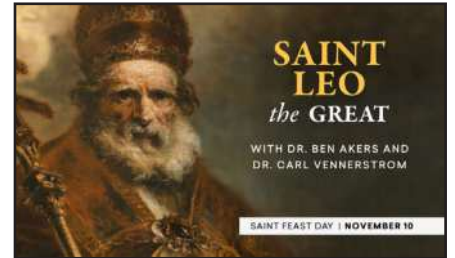

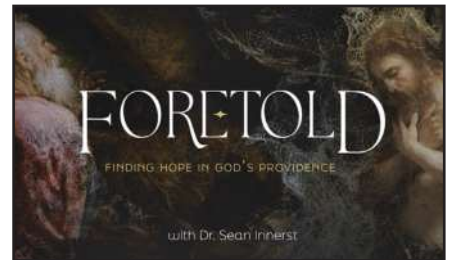

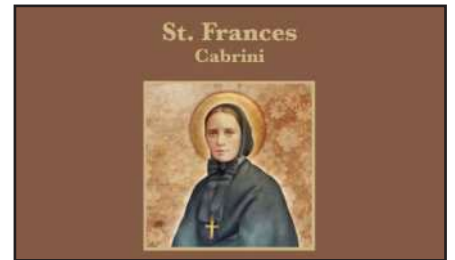

Natural Family Planning

Côr Fertilty and Divine Grace Parish are offering the Billings Ovulation Method Class, one of several approaches to Natural Family Planning. By learning their body's natural observable signs women can become their own health advocate, achieve or postpone pregnancy, and monitor their overall health.

Unpacking the Word

— Ezekiel 47:1-2, 8-9, 12 —

Today's feast is unique in the liturgical calendar. It is focused on a building instead of on a saint or an event. The Basilica of Saint John Lateran, dedicated both to Saint John the Baptist and to Saint John the Evangelist and located on the Lateran Hill in Rome, is the cathedral church of the Diocese of Rome; it is the mother church of the Mother Church. The anniversary of its dedication is an important event for Catholics everywhere and serves as an opportunity to meditate on the Lord's providence of a Church, a Mystical Body united to Jesus through faith and the sacraments, and not simply to a physical structure in Italy.

Our reading from the Prophet Ezekiel comes from his vision of a New Temple in a New Jerusalem. Ezekiel had been swept into exile by the Babylonians in the first wave of deportations that occurred around 597 B.C., roughly ten years before the Babylonians would destroy the Temple in Jerusalem. Ezekiel's visions recorded at the end of his very well-organized book were meant to bring hope to the exiles. Someday, the Lord would restore the Temple, but it would be a Temple unlike anything they could have imagined. At the end of the exile, some Jews returned and built a far less impressive Temple, and later on King Herod would greatly embellish it. This was not the Temple of Ezekiel's vision, and the Romans destroyed it in 70 A.D.

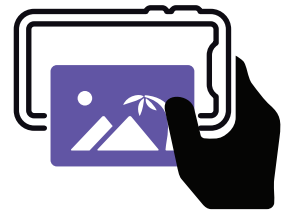
Jesus Christ is the New Temple. Both in his personal body and in his Mystical Body, his Church, he is the locus of worship and the source of life that the earthly Temple merely represented. The water flowing from the right side of the Temple in Ezekiel's vision represents the sacraments, which are "powers that come forth from the Body of Christ" (Catechism of the Catholic Church, 1116). Our church buildings, including the Lateran Basilica, provide places for us to gather as a Church and encounter these powers. Today's feast is not merely about the history of a physical structure. It is about the living structure that Jesus Christ built, nourishes, and continues to lead, a living structure whose visible aspect is manifest in many buildings throughout the world, including one very important one on a hill in Rome.

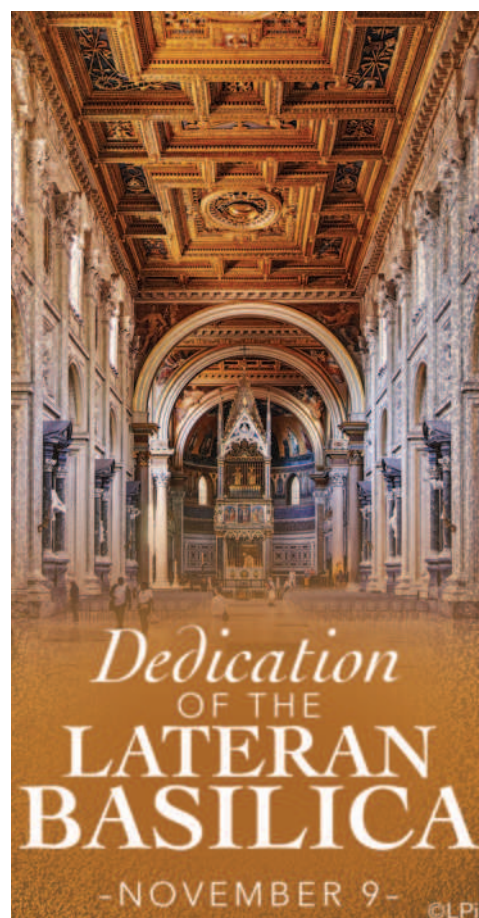
