

## Solemnity of the Holy Family

This weekend we celebrate the mystery of God coming to us in the person of Jesus within the context of family life. The baby Jesus had to be cared for – protected, fed, and raised. With the love of a mother and foster father, God submits Himself to this holy family. Let us pray for all families this weekend; those with single parents, those who are widowed, for the divorced, marriages under financial and social stresses, and for our parish family that we may continue to grow in faith.

## The Eight Days of Christmas

Did you know that we celebrate Christmas Day for eight days straight? This is called the “Octave” of Christmas. The use of octave celebrations was a Jewish custom that we see in Bible times. The Christmas season ends on the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord (**Sunday, January 11**) but the Octave is celebrated through **Thurs., January 1**. Keep celebrating Christmas!

## Saint Thomas Becket

On **Monday, December 29**, the Christmas Octave wants us to remember Saint Thomas Becket, who served as Lord Chancellor of England and then as the Archbishop of Canterbury. He refused to have the Church submit her authority to that of King Henry II. Saint Thomas was stabbed to death in the Cathedral by the King's soldiers. King Henry repented and asked the Pope to canonize Thomas as a Saint. Saint Thomas, pray for us!

## Saint Pope Sylvester I

On **Wednesday, December 31**, the Church wants us to remember the pope who reigned secretly in fear of Emperor Constantine in the early 4<sup>th</sup> century. However, the emperor was in battle to protect Rome and defeated the invaders. He saw a cross in the sky during battle and asked his general which gods does this sign belong to.

They responded it was not a Roman god sign, rather one that the illegal Christians used for God. The emperor met with Pope Sylvester, legalized Christianity, and would be baptized Catholic before his death. Pope Sylvester, pray for us!

## Mary, Mother of God – Holy Day

This Wednesday evening and on Thursday, the Church celebrates the motherhood of Mary as we begin the new year. Jesus would give to us His mother to be the Mother of the whole Church. The Mass schedule for New Year's Eve and New Year's Day is found on page 5.

## Saint Gregory Feast Day

The patron Saint of our church, Saint Gregory, will be celebrated this **Friday, January 2**. We will have donuts and coffee in the narthex following the 9:00 am Mass. Saint Gregory was a great teacher of the faith and served as the Patriarch of Constantinople until his death at the end of the 4<sup>th</sup> century. He defended the Nicene Creed that we recite on Sundays against those who did not believe Jesus to be God or Mary to be the Mother of God. We need his prayers as many Christians today do not believe in the Eucharist as the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ. Pray for us, Saint Gregory!

## The Holy Family Shows Us How **CATHOLIC PARENTS R.O.C.K.**

It's not easy growing up Catholic today, but we only need to revisit the story of the Holy Family to recall that Mary and Joseph also faced big challenges. They endured poverty and persecution, were forced to flee their homeland, and dealt with the difficulties of raising a child who was fully divine and human.

**Andrea and David Losos** also understand adversity. As the parents of nine children between the ages of 17 and one, they rely on a deep faith and an abiding trust in God in a secular society. They know that it takes a "village" to raise a child and are hoping that other parents at Divine Grace Parish will join them in the creation of a new ministry called **Catholic Parents R.O.C.K. (Raising Our Catholic Kids)**. The goal is to help Catholic parents form their kids in faith, virtue, and love, while creating a network to help one another in the vocation of raising future generations of the Church.

Catholic Parents R.O.C.K. will be held for five months beginning **Thursday, January 15** at 6:30 pm in the Holy Redeemer convent. Each 75 to 90-minute session will include prayer, teaching/reflection, group discussion, and a practical takeaway.

"The challenges of modern-day parenting are staggering – we have to compete with technology, increased hostility towards Christian values, and a society where many young people are losing their faith in God," David said. "Catholic parents need community and support now more than ever."

"We are constantly battling the culture," Andrea adds. "We want to help strengthen and support Catholic families and marriages by offering a venue to discuss challenges and find solutions."



### Living Rosary on January 12



— Sirach 3:2-6, 12-14 —

**The family is the cell of society, its basic building block.** Even if we have no family of our own, every one of us is the product of one. Family is therefore universal, which is to say it is catholic. The Feast of the Holy Family focuses our attention on one of the hallmarks of a holy family: honor for parents. The first reading from Sirach, which is a summary of the Israelite wisdom tradition after the convergence of Jewish piety and Greek philosophy, dives into the parent-child relationship of love and honor at the heart of family life.

**In Catholic catechetical tradition, the Fourth Commandment to honor one's parents** is the first commandment on the second tablet, the first one related to love of neighbor. However, in the Jewish tradition, it is the final commandment on the first tablet dealing with love of God. The point here, which Sirach assumes, is that by honoring our parents, we honor the Lord. Sirach specifies that honoring parents atones for sins, just like the bloody sacrifices of the Temple liturgy brought about atonement under the Old Covenant and the sacrifice of Jesus brought about the ultimate atonement in the New Covenant. Honoring our parents, at any age, is a sacred participation in Jesus' sacrifice out of obedience to the Father. It makes our families holy.

**Honor for parents is so important to the Lord that he attaches some remarkable blessings to it.** In addition to atoning for sins it also results in a fruitful prayer life and makes for a happy family life. We can see this in Jesus' own family life growing up, where he himself "was obedient to them [i.e. Mary and Joseph]" (Luke 2:51). The Holy Family was by no means exempt from difficulties (see the Flight to Egypt in Matthew 2:13-23), but they experienced the simple joys of a loving family that honored the Lord by honoring one another.

**On this Holy Family Sunday, the Lord asks us to consider the role of honor within our families.** Perhaps you need to work on showing greater honor, on honoring the memory of your deceased parents, or on showing honor despite a difficult phase in the relationship. Or perhaps he is simply reminding you of the blessings he has given you for your efforts at keeping the Fourth Commandment. Family is important, and families striving for holiness can reign down blessings upon the world.
