

Laetare Sunday

This weekend we celebrate what the Church refers to as Laetare Sunday. *Laetare* is Latin for “rejoice.” If we have been faithful to our Lenten disciplines then we are beginning to see how the Divine Grace of Our Lord is helping us to a deeper conversion to Jesus as we prepare for Easter. So, “rejoice” that the mercy of God is helping us to be the saints that our Lord calls us to be.

Saint Patrick – The Great Evangelizer

Tuesday is the Feast of Saint Patrick who has an amazing story – from being a slave to becoming a priest, then the first Archbishop of Armagh in Ireland in the 4th century. Miracles are attributed to him in his lifetime and since. Saint Patrick’s Day commemorates the Catholic Church in Ireland, the mission of evangelization, and how faith and culture can promote the best of society. Thanks to Saint Patrick, tens of thousands of Irish pagans became Catholic. His feast day is NOT about beer and green outfits. Saint Patrick – pray for us as we continue our evangelizing work at Divine Grace Parish.

Saint Cyril of Jerusalem

Cyril was consecrated the Bishop of Jerusalem in 348. He authored a number of catechetical and pastoral teachings to assist adults who were becoming Catholic. The process to initiate adult Catholics is now called the Order of Christian Initiation of Adults. Saint Cyril can be considered the “father” of this process. Our parish will initiate 10 new Catholics at the Easter Vigil. *Saint Cyril – pray for us!*

Pray for the Repose of Pope Francis

On March 19, 2013, Pope Francis was installed as the Supreme Pastor of the Universal Church in Saint Peter’s Square. Although he has passed away, how about saying a prayer for him this Thursday. May he rest in peace.

Solemnity of Saint Joseph

This Thursday the Church celebrates the great Solemnity of Saint Joseph as the husband and spouse of the Blessed Mother. Pope Pius X declared him as Patron of the Universal Church in 1870. He is the patron saint of fathers, workers, and carpenters. Let us pray for the men of the parish that they can follow the virtues of Saint Joseph.

Joyful Anticipation

IN A TIME OF PREPARATION

Laetare Sunday – coming about halfway through the Lenten season – has a different look and feel, something that **Deacon Don Pepe** calls “a bright spot.”

Latin for “rejoice,” Laetare Sunday encourages us to pause in the penitential season of Lent to give thanks for God’s love and the joy of salvation.

“For many people, Lent is a time of reflection and repentance,” Deacon Don said. “Laetare Sunday helps us find joy in act of penance, lifting up our hearts in a positive and joyful way.”

Fr. Jim Wehner urges us to “rejoice that the mercy of God is helping us to be the saints that our Lord calls us to be.”

We have good reason to rejoice because through Jesus we have received healing. And if we live by the kind of love that Jesus shows us from the cross, we too can be life-giving, offering help and healing to others.

Similar to Gaudete Sunday in Advent, which also features the liturgical color of rose, Laetare Sunday invites us into a joyful anticipation within a time of preparation. Rejoicing in our faith comes from the certainty of salvation through the redemption of the cross, the gift of eternal life, and God’s presence even in the midst of suffering.

We rejoice that Jesus has conquered sin and death, that God is with us and will never abandon us, that we are His beloved daughters and sons, and receive graces from the Eucharist and other sacraments.

Sharing the joy of the Gospel in the mission of Christ also brings a sense of purpose and joy, serving as a witness to others.

Easter is just three weeks away. Let’s rejoice and make the most of the rest of Lent.



Unpacking the Word

— 1 Samuel 16:1b, 6-7, 10-13a —

Israel was supposed to be a theocracy, a people ruled by God himself. However, during the period of the Judges (roughly a few hundred years leading up to 1,000 B.C., give or take), the people grew tired of the instability that resulted from the cycle of committing sin, falling into slavery, crying out in supplication, and the Lord providing a savior (see the entire *Book of Judges*). Eventually the people demanded “a king to govern us like all the nations” (1 Samuel 8:7). They gave up being special, set apart, holy, to be just like all the other nations. And the Lord granted their demand!

Israel’s first king, Saul, proved to be a bad king, insisting on doing things his way and not following the Lord’s directives through the Prophet Samuel. While Saul was still living, the Lord sent Samuel to anoint the next king, as we read in the First Reading. This is the first of three times that David is anointed as king. Here in 1 Samuel 16, the anointing marks the child David as the future king once King Saul dies. In 2 Samuel 2:4, he is anointed as king of the tribe of Judah, and in 2 Samuel 5:3 he is anointed as king over all Israel at the age of thirty.

David’s first anointing points ahead to what the Spirit’s anointing will look like in the New Covenant, the anointing that you and I received in Baptism and Confirmation. Other Old Testament figures were filled with the Spirit temporarily for a specific task. Yet with David, “from that day on, the spirit of the LORD rushed upon David.” The Spirit descended and remained, like he did at Jesus’ Baptism (see John 1:33), and at your Baptism. It is only because of this indwelling of the Spirit that David is able to fulfill his mission to lead God’s people as their king, and David knows it. After his sin with Bathsheba in 2 Samuel 11, David begged, “take not

your holy Spirit from me” (Psalm 51:11). The Spirit who overshadowed Mary at the Annunciation (see Luke 1:35) and who overshadowed the Apostles at Pentecost (see Acts 2:1-4) enabled David, Mary, and the Apostles to fulfill their God-given mission in the world in ways that only they could.

Here is the takeaway. If you have been anointed by this same Spirit through Baptism and Confirmation, then you have everything you need to do God’s work in your life, to be a holy spouse and parent, a holy child and sibling, a holy business leader or employee, to bring hope and healing to your family, friends, and neighbors. It’s already in you. There was a time when it was not, but the Lord picked you because he sees “not as man sees.” He sees in you what you might not be able to see yourself. You are not too old or too young. The Lord wants to change the world through you in the circumstances you find yourself in right now. It is the reason he gave you his Spirit in the first place.




