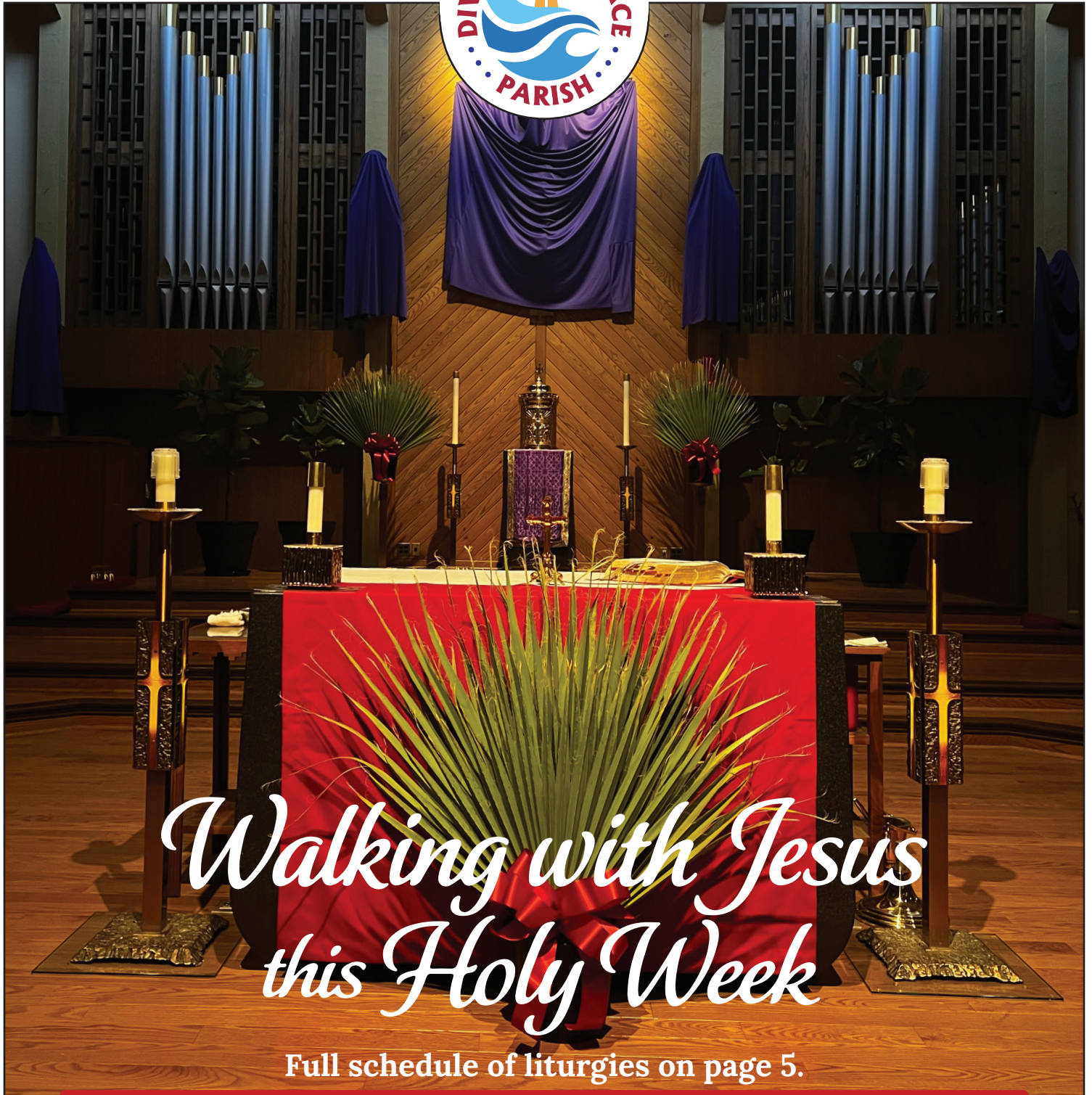

## Triumphal Entry into Jerusalem: Palm Sunday

This weekend we prepare for the great events of our salvation. The Church recalls on Palm Sunday the triumphal entrance of Jesus into Jerusalem. This is where the Temple is located, where Mary and Joseph brought Jesus as a baby. It is the city where Jesus will celebrate the Passover by instituting the Holy Eucharist. It is here where Jesus will be crucified and where he first appears after the Resurrection. We are not spectators of these events; rather, through Baptism, we become sharers of the very mysteries we celebrate.

## Spy Wednesday

We hear in the Gospel of Matthew how Judas prepares to betray Jesus. Older people might remember that this day was known as Spy Wednesday. Since we are all sinners, it is a reminder that anytime we sin, we too are betraying Jesus. May we make every effort to repent from sin and believe in the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

## The Chrism Mass

All clergy will gather on Thursday at Saint Paul Cathedral to renew our priestly promises. The Bishop will bless the three oils that are used for the sacraments – the oil of the catechumenate (used at baptism), the chrism oil (used at baptism, confirmation, and priestly ordination) and the oil of the sick (used for the anointing of the sick and for last rites). Members from our parish will retrieve the newly blessed oils.

## Holy Thursday Mass – Eucharist and Priesthood

Lent concludes with the beginning of the Mass of the Last Supper on Holy Thursday. All three churches will remain open until 11:00 pm for people to make a visit and pray before the Holy Eucharist. The Sacred Triduum consists of Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and the Great

Vigil of Easter. On Thursday we celebrate Jesus instituting the Holy Eucharist as well as the ordained priesthood. These mysteries are at the heart of our Catholic faith. Without the priesthood, there is no Eucharist, and without the Eucharist there is no Church.

## Good Friday

This is the only day of the year when Mass is prohibited – not even a funeral Mass is permitted. We observe that Jesus is executed with the Roman death penalty of crucifixion. The Passion Liturgy is celebrated, we reverence the Cross, and we do receive Holy Communion which will be consecrated at the Holy Thursday Mass.

## The Great Vigil of Easter

The Easter Vigil Mass is a culmination of all that we Catholics profess and believe. We begin outside the church with the blessing of the Easter Fire and Easter Candle. We hear the Old and New Testament readings. The Great Alleluia is sung. After the homily, we reject Satan and renew our Catholic faith. This Mass is the mother of all liturgies. The Easter Vigil will be celebrated at 8:30 pm at Saint Ferdinand and Holy Redeemer churches.

## Easter Sunday Masses

Sunday Masses are as usual; however, we added a Noon Mass at Saint Gregory and there will be no 5:00 pm Mass at Saint Ferdinand.

# THE HOLY TRIDUUM



## Making the Most of the Sacred Triduum

Latin for “three days,” the Triduum is the pinnacle of the Catholic liturgical year, beginning Holy Thursday evening and lasting through the Easter Vigil on Saturday night. This continuous celebration encompasses most of the Paschal Mystery – Christ’s passion, death, and resurrection.

- **Holy Thursday** – Mass of the Lord’s Supper, beginning at sundown, commemorating Jesus’ last meal with the apostles, the institution of the Eucharist, and the priesthood.
- **Good Friday** – Liturgy of the Lord’s Passion. Not a Mass, it is a solemn service with the reading of the Passion, Veneration of the Cross, and Holy Communion. Strict fasting and abstinence from meat are observed.
- **Holy Saturday** – Easter Vigil. The high point of the Triduum, held after sundown, the Vigil begins with the service of light, then Scripture, baptismal rites and culminates in the Eucharist.

How to fully join in: Prepare by making a good confession. On Holy Thursday, spend time in prayer after Mass. Pray the Stations of the Cross on Good Friday. Spend Holy Saturday in quiet reflection and waiting, as Jesus is in the tomb. Above all, unplug and limit distractions to help make this your best Triduum yet.

## Plenary Indulgences for the Triduum

A plenary indulgence is a grace granted by the Church through the merits of Jesus Christ, Our Lady, and the Saints to remove temporal punishment due to sin. While sins are forgiven in the sacrament of penance, there is temporal punishment to cleanse our souls in preparation for Heaven. During the Triduum, plenary indulgence can be obtained for oneself or for a deceased person.

**Holy Thursday** – spend 30 minutes before the Blessed Sacrament after the Lord’s Supper and recite the verses of the Tantum Ergo hymn.

**Good Friday** – venerate the cross during the Lord’s Passion Liturgy and pray the Stations of the Cross.

**Holy Saturday** – two or more people pray the Rosary and attend the Easter Vigil in which we renew our baptismal promises.

The following also must be observed: Go to confession a few days before or after, receive Holy Communion on the day you are seeking the indulgence, and pray for the intentions of Pope Leo IV (Our Father, Hail Mary, Glory Be).

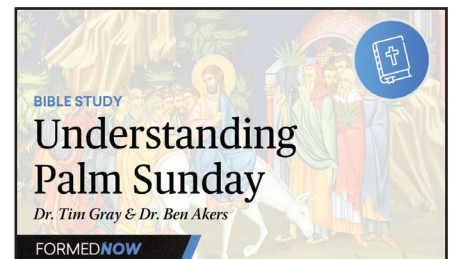
## The Last Days: The Passion and Death of Jesus

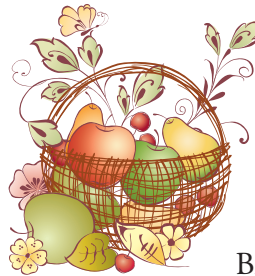

### Entering into the Triduum

Jesus' death on the cross served as more than God's ultimate sacrifice of unconditional love. It was the realization of Jewish law. Dr. Michael Mullock, MD, will present "The Fulfillment of Jewish Sacrifice in the Cross of Christ" on **Wednesday, April 1** following 9:00 am Mass at Holy Redeemer Church. Enter into the Triduum like never before.

### Good Friday Procession

The faithful are invited to take part in a procession in Ellwood City on Good Friday. Following the liturgy service at 2:00 pm in Holy Redeemer Church, we will process with a statue of the Body of the Expired Jesus. This symbolizes the taking of Jesus from the cross to the tomb. The procession is about a half-mile long, on 4th Street to Lawrence Ave. to 6th Street, then down Wolverine Ave. and back to Holy Redeemer. The Divine Mercy Chaplet also will be prayed during this time in the church.

### Serving those in Need

— Isaiah 50:4-7 —

On at least three different occasions, Jesus predicted his Passion, and yet his disciples and even the Apostles were stunned when it actually happened. However, within a very short time, they all suddenly were convinced that the death of the Messiah fulfilled centuries old prophecies. As we mark another Passion Sunday, the Church presents to us one of the clearest prophecies of the death of the Messiah in the third Servant Song of Isaiah.

The four Servant Songs describe, and at times are the very voice of, a mysterious figure whom Isaiah calls simply “the Servant of the Lord.” The Servant is the embodiment of faithful Israel, and as such he has a mission to bring people back into covenant relationship with their Creator. What is most striking about these songs is how clearly they play out in Jesus’ Passion. The ultimate Servant of the Lord, Jesus will press on to fulfill his mission despite the persecution he will endure: “I gave my back to those who beat me, my cheeks to those who plucked my beard.” Despite disgraceful treatment at the hands of his countrymen, the Servant is “not disgraced.” Despite the shameful death that will fulfill this prophecy, the Servant “shall not be put to shame.” The Servant accepts this physical abuse without fighting back, without pointing out the injustice of it all, and without the masochist’s shameful pleasure in it. He exhibits the epitome of the spiritual work of mercy to bear wrongs patiently.

Like so many Old Testament passages before it, this Servant Song was shrouded in mystery to most people until Jesus came and fulfilled it in a shockingly literal way. We must not lose sight of how stunning the Passion is, of its shock value. We have heard and told this story over and over again so many times that it can begin to

feel like just a familiar story with a nice ending. While Jesus will not be disgraced or put to shame, it would be nothing short of a shameful disgrace if we allow his Passion to remain just a familiar story.

Today, the Spirit is reminding us that our Creator freely became human and allowed us to kill him. He did not fight back or lecture us on the great sin of deicide. Rather he uses this great sin against God himself to take away all sins, your sins and my sins, because our Creator would literally rather die than risk spending eternity without us. When the first Christians grasped this stunning reality, they could not help but tell their friends and neighbors about it. Our friends and neighbors today long to hear this all-too-familiar “story” too. Will you tell them?



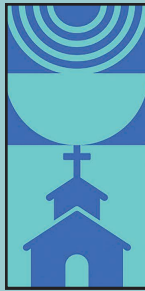

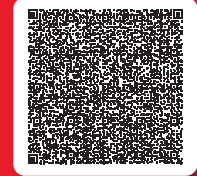
