

# 7th Grade Curriculum Summary

7th grade Faith Formation at Home addresses each line of the Creed, the basic summary statement of Christian belief. The Catholic Vision of Love sections address Christian dating and the concept of chastity for guys and for girls. The outline of the video titles are below. We encourage parents to watch these videos ahead of time or with your child so that you can discuss the videos with them.

There are Parent, Participant, and Leader guides under each video session on Formed.org that includes discussion questions, Bible verses, quotes, etc. that you can use to help facilitate discussion with your child. You do not have to use these discussion resources, but they may be helpful.
