

Confirmation Name Reflection

A Confirmation Name is the name of Saint whom a candidate for Confirmation chooses to be his/her heavenly patron for the rest of his/her life. To help you choose a Confirmation Name, consider the following questions:

- 1. Why did your parents choose the name they gave you? Were you named after a beloved relative or a favorite saint? If so, who? What about this person inspired them to name you?
- 2. What does your name mean? (Ex: "George" means "farmer" [www.BehindTheName.com])
- 3. What is the name of someone whom you see as a good role model of faith?
- 4. What does that person's name mean, and which Saints are associated with it?
- 5. What are a few other names that you like (because they are strong names, pretty names, etc.)?
- 6. What does each of these names mean, and which Saints are associated with them?
- 7. Who is your favorite Saint, or who is the Saint celebrated on your birthday? What does this name mean?
- 8. What is a personality trait(s) of a holy person that you would like to develop? (Expatience, piety, humility, etc)
- 9. What name(s) mean these traits? (Ex: Irene is a female name that means "peace")

Now that you have several meaningful names to work with, you need to choose one that will be your Confirmation Name. Once you have chosen a name, find a Saint that is associated with that name. If there is no Saint with your name, try to find a Saint with a derivation of your name (i.e. Giovanni, Joan, Janis, Johanna, Sean, Ivan, Juan, and Jean are all derivations of John). Regardless of your gender, you can choose a Saint of either gender.
