



Life Center St. Mary's Parish has an opportunity for a parish weekend at the diocesan-owned property, Pyramid Life Center, Friday, July 5th —


Sunday, July 7th. Mass will be celebrated on the weekend with and for all those at camp.





Health Ministry Short Health Tips




