## 5TH SUNDAY OF EASTER



**D**uring the Last Supper, Jesus' final night with his disciples, he revealed a compelling acclamation, saying, "I am the vine, you are the branches. Whoever remains in me and I in him will bear much fruit, because without me you can do nothing." (John 15:5) Jesus is the vine and God, the Father is the farmer, or the vinedresser, who planted and cares for the vine. Disciples of Christ are the branches. There are those who bear fruit and those who do not. The disciples who do not bear fruit are cut off and thrown in hell, because there is no life or truth in them. Don't be cut off and cast aside. Put your live into proper perspective. There is nothing is more important than salvation. Nothing is more important than eternal life. Nothing is more important than Heaven and being with God for all eternity. Jesus said, "I am the Resurrection and the Life." (John 11:25) "I am the Way, the truth and the Life. Help them to experience the love and mercy of Christ, your Son. **R.**


Mary, Intercessor and Advocate,

And show the world the extravagant love of God. **R.**



## 3rd grade had a very busy month in March.

The 3rd grade class led their first service project, led Lenten mass at church, led Morning Prayer for the school, created leprechaun traps, had PIE day and joined Mrs. O'Brien's kindergarten class for Dr. Seuss's birthday.

On March 2nd Mrs. O'Brien's kindergarten class joined the 3rd grade class in the technology hall for some Dr. Seuss read-aloud. Scholars wore crazy socks and read their favorite Dr. Seuss books.

On Friday, March 12th 3rd grade celebrated Pi Day (Pie Day). Two weeks prior to Pi Day 3rd grade has been learning all about understanding fractions as numbers. So what better way to understand this concept even better by eating fractions of blueberry, wild berry and apply pie.


For three weeks in March the scholars worked on a paper on how to make a leprechaun trap. On the third week of March they started creating them. On Wednesday, March 17th the 3rd grade scholars joined Mrs. O'Brien's kindergarten class. The kindergartners read stories to the 3rd grade scholars and then the 3rd grade scholars taught the kindergartners how to make a leprechaun trap. On Wednesday, March 24th the 3rd grade class joined 2nd, 4th and the 5th grade classes as they asked God to bless us and to help us in our faith journey this Lent....

....as we pray more,

....as we fast from all those ways that keeps us from growing closer to God

....as we make sacrifices in our Rice Bowls.

On Thursday, March 25th the 3rd grade class led the kindergarten and 1st grade classes in a Lenten prayer service. The 3rd grade class taught the younger



scholars that for Lent we try to follow Jesus. We follow Jesus by: helping other people or classmates, giving up things, saying an extra prayer, doing extra kind acts, giving to the poor = rice bowl or being thankful. We do all of these things during Lent to prepare for Easter.

Lastly, during the Lenten season our 3rd grade service project was the rice bowl. We were excited to be doing this project, which focuses on three things--praying, fasting and giving. We were hoping our families would give back to our global family. Our goal was \$1.00 a day or \$40 a person. Our 3rd grade scholars collected from all the classrooms on Wednesday, March 31st and collected \$1,355.06. It was a very successful service project.
