their trust in the God who gave them life. **R.**


Mary, Mother of the Word Incarnate, you bore in your




The Nicene Creed

Of the two creeds, the Nicene Creed is “the long one.”

It is an expansion upon the Apostles Creed and named after the Councils of Nicaea and Constantinople, where many heresies (beliefs contrary to Church Doctrine) on the Sonship of Jesus and the Holy Spirit were put to rest. Over the years, adjustments to the vocabulary and other additions have been made to more accurately profess our belief in the Trinity. While the Creed was written in the 4th century, it wasn't until the 6th century that it was integrated into the Sacred Liturgy. This was done to help keep these beliefs in the minds of the clergy and congregation to help mitigate further heresy against the Trinity.





